The dance department is housed in Culford Hall, boasting stunning Georgian architecture. The dance studios have a purpose built Harlequin sprung floor, ballet barres and mirrors. Our expert, professionally trained staff deliver training in these state-of-the-art facilities.

All pupils will have the opportunity to develop their performance skills through our annual dance shows, choreographic and solos competitions, as well as other events at school and in the community.

Culford's young dancers are given the challenge of developing a creative score, learning and appreciating the choreographic process and journey. Thinking dancers make better dancers.

Our Summer, Easter and day intensive courses are an opportunity to hone dance skills during an immersive artistic experience developing technical, artistic and creative dance skills delivered in a studio setting, studio theatre and main stage.
