FOOD SERVICES INFORMATION 2023/24

Welcome to the Lampeter-Strasburg School District! Our food service department offers nutritious breakfast and lunch options for all full-day students and children enrolled in our School Age Child Care (SACC) program. Our meals meet federal and state guidelines.

What Is Available?

Daily breakfast offerings include 2 servings of whole grains or 2 servings meat or 1 of each, 2 servings of fruit and 1 serving milk. Lunch for grades 1-5 includes serving of meat, serving of grain, 2 vegetables, 1 fruit (fresh or canned) and choice of milk. Meat and grain servings are slightly larger for grades 6-8 and includes 2 vegetables, 1 fruit (fresh or canned) and choice of milk. Meat and grain servings are slightly larger for grades 9-12 and includes 2 vegetables, 2 fruits (fresh or canned) and choice of milk. Additional options are available for students in grades 6-12.

How Much Do Meals Cost?

Breakfast is FREE TO ALL STUDENTS IN PA FOR THE 2023-24 SCHOOL YEAR. Lunch is \$2.85 for grades K-5, \$3.00 for grades 6-8, and \$3.25 for grades 9-12. Milk costs \$.60. Free and reduced lunches are available by application. Application can be completed at:

What has changed?

Students who are classified as Reduced will also now be FREE for lunch. We are encouraging all families to consider applying for Free/Reduced meals. Students will NOT be allowed to charge any à la carte or extra items. They must have money in their accounts to purchase.

How Can I Pay?

The district has partnered with SchoolCafe for lunch accounts. Alternatively, money may be sent with your child (cash or checks) to the attention of the cafeteria staff. Checks should be made payable to L-S Cafeteria.

What Happens at the End of the Year?

Money left in a student's account will move with that student to the next grade and/or building. If a student is leaving the district, please complete a form for reimbursement available in the school's main office.
