All,

I had a number of questions from the exciting news yesterday so I write to share additional information. Some requested a copy of the Statement of Interest (SOI) that was submitted in June 2021 as the preliminary application for entrance into the [Massachusetts School Building Authority \(MSBA\)](#) non-entitlement competitive program. Please find the DCRSD SOI attached. The SOI is not an invitation into the program it is only an initial step. The Dudley-Charlton RSD filed an SOI for Shepherd Hill with the MSBA in 2006, 2008, and 2009 through 2021. This is our first invitation for Shepherd Hill. Note that the 2021 SOI does not tell the whole story as there are many steps and years of work ahead to include our recent invitation into [Eligibility](#). A [Feasibility Study](#) will reveal the building conditions in totality.

As previously shared, this multiyear endeavor is well prescribed and requires community voice throughout. Communicated information will be constant, consistent and continuous starting September 1, 2022. As an example of process, timeline and information outcome, I invite you to look at the Town of Bourne's [website](#) for a recent Bourne Public Schools MSBA school building project. Again, this is a long, multiyear process where community and constituency voice is required.
