Shepherd Hill Regional High School has officially entered the Massachusetts School Building Authorities (MSBA) Eligibility Period as of September 1, 2022. One of the required steps is to establish a Shepherd Hill School Building Committee (SHSBC). At the regularly scheduled School Committee meeting of August 24, 2022, the Dudley-Charlton Regional School Committee established the membership makeup of the SHSBC. Please see the approved SHSBC makeup on page 2 of the attachment. As a result, the communities of Charlton and Dudley will identify two community representatives to join the SHSBC. The Massachusetts School Building Authority and the Dudley-Charlton Regional School Committee is looking for a community representative who is a local budget official or a FINCOM/FAA member and a representative who has architectural, engineering or construction experience. The town will establish their own process for identifying their representative members. Community members should contact their town administrator's offices if you are interested. The SHSBC could minimally be a 3-5-year commitment, if we meet all of the MSBA requirements and the town voters support the efforts of the SHSBC to renovate the SHRHS.
