Application Process and Checklist

ELIGIBILITY

To be considered for admission for the school year 2024-2025:

- Male applicants must be three (Preschool 3) or four (Preschool 4) years old by July 1, 2024.
- Female applicants must be three (Preschool 3) or four (Preschool 4) years old by September 1, 2024.

REQUIRED STEPS:

- Create an online [myPueo](#) account.

DUE NOVEMBER 1

- Complete an application form and submit a \$125 non-refundable application fee.

DUE JANUARY 10

- Complete the Parent/Guardian Summary

The perspective provided by parents/guardians is highly valued. The Parent/Guardian Summary is an opportunity for parents/guardians to provide information about the unique qualities of the student, family, and interest in Mid-Pacific.

- Attend a Preschool Information Session (Parents/Guardians Only)*

After your application form and fee have been submitted, register for an on-campus Preschool Information Session held in November and December. This is an opportunity to learn about Mid-Pacific's Reggio-Emilia inspired program, curriculum, and educational approach.

- Attend a Play and Observation Session (with applicant)*

Applicants will be scheduled by the admissions office for a 30-minute group play and observation session on a Saturday during December or January. One parent/guardian will be allowed to accompany the student into the classroom during the observation session.

- Attend a Parent/Guardian Virtual Follow-up Meeting (Parents/Guardians Only)

UA 20-minute virtual parent/guardian follow-up meeting will be scheduled after the applicant has completed the play and observation session. This is an opportunity for parents/guardians to receive feedback from the play and observation session.

**Please contact the admissions office if residing off-island for a virtual option.*

OPTIONAL RECOMMENDED STEPS:

- Attend Open House - October 21, 2023
- Schedule a campus tour
- Upload Preschool video

Provide a 2-minute video of the applicant at play or doing an activity of interest.

- Attend a Parent/Guardian Virtual Follow-up Meeting (Parents/Guardians Only)

A 20-minute virtual parent/guardian follow-up meeting may be scheduled after the applicant has completed the assessment. This is an opportunity for parents/guardians to receive feedback from the assessment.

FOR INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS ONLY:

- Upload Passport
- Upload Visa (if applicable)
- Complete the International Supplement Form

The International Supplement Form allows parents/guardians to provide information about the applicant's anticipated immigration status and living arrangements upon enrollment.
