Nomination</p>	<p>The purpose of the Wilson Area School District Hall of Fame is to recognize Wilson Area School District graduates, who have distinguished themselves by their individual contributions in scholarship, athletics, the fine arts, career, community service, and/or personal achievements. The honor of being elected to the Hall of Fame will represent individuals who, through their individual actions, have contributed to the established vision of the District. Selected Hall of Fame inductees will demonstrate the positive impact that Wilson Area School District has made on them. Selected Hall of Fame inductees must have served as positive role models that can provide inspiration, hope, support and relevance to our current students as they progress through their own areas of study, athletics, extracurricular activities or community service.</p> <p>To qualify for the Hall of Fame:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">A. The graduate must have earned individual recognition by his/her scholastic achievements, accomplishments in athletics, the fine arts, career or community service.B. The graduate must have earned individual recognition after graduation by his/her postsecondary scholastic achievements, athletic, musical, or career/professional accomplishments, military service, or community service.C. The graduate must have lived an exemplary life of community service and good character must have followed the nominee after graduation. <p>Applications for nomination may be obtained by contacting the District office or High School office. Nomination of an individual may be made by submitting a completed nomination form. Any graduate of the High School, past or present employee, or past or present resident of the District may submit a nomination. A nomination submitted will continue in the active nomination file for five (5) years. A graduate nominee will become eligible five (5) years after graduation unless waived due to the nominee being deceased.</p>
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4. Selection Process	<p>A selection committee of nine members shall meet yearly to review applications and select members to the Hall of Fame. A 2/3 vote is necessary for admission. When applications exceed the number of available selections, they will be selected in order of most votes cast with a simple majority minimum required. The number selected for enshrinement shall not exceed three per year.</p>
5. Enshrinement	<p>A plaque shall be erected in the designated area of the High School and a similar plaque shall be given to the recipient or their representative. Acknowledgement of enshrinement shall be made at the commencement exercises beginning with the Class of 1999.</p>
6. Selection Committee	<p>Selection Committee shall consist of:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Administrator (High School Principal or Superintendent)2. Two School Board members3. Athletic Director4. One High School academic department chair5. Three community members6. One member of a municipal or township government (Optional) <p>All appointments shall be confirmed by the School Board for a period of three years with one-third of appointments confirmed each year. Those serving may continue with no limit to terms.</p>
