## **North Kitsap Athletic Booster Club** **General Meeting – December 14, 2022**

- **Call to Order:** J. Pruden called to order at 6:40 p.m. S. Pickard seconded. All approved.
- **Officers Present:**

- **Treasurer Report:**
  - General Account \$7, 178.62. Scholarship \$2,511.81, Spirit Fund Cash is \$945 and \$1200 in savings.
  - Approved C. Blackwood, softball, for reimbursement in the amount of \$1,334.28 for state visors, state t-shirts and end of year banquet supplies
  - Approved J. Leslie, Athletic Medicine, for reimbursement in the amount of \$1,359.93 for food for travel, fall recognition and organization supplies for Athletic Medicine room.
- **Secretary Report:**
  - M. Hendryx motion to approve, S. Pickard seconded
- **Membership**
  - All sports teams have a coach as a member but cross-country and golf.. The cross-country coach will join next year now that he understands the benefits of membership.
- **Scholarship:**
  - Boosters will sell slices of pizza at the Wrestling tournament on March 10-11 to raise funds for scholarship. Wrestling will run general concessions. Kevin working with Town and Country to see if they can help us in some form ( i.e. donating pizza, discounting, providing, warmers, etc.).
  - To serve pizza at wrestling tournament we will need a hot hold procedure. Pizza bags may be one way to do this. Sell pizza slices from 11:30 am to 1:30 pm.
  - Joanna to follow up with district to see if we can offer a student scholarship (\$250) for submitting the art work to paint mural on stadium press box. If not approved to do there, to ask for approval to do a mural in the gym.
- **Student of the Month:**
  - Nikki has finished the Olympic Themed “Student of the Month” bulletin board. Pictures of student of the month athletes to be put on the stars.
- **Fundraising:**
  - Wrestling cookie verbally approved at the meeting. Paperwork is still needed.
  - Girls basketball shoot-a-thon and staff vs. team basketball game fundraisers approved.
  - Baseball Christmas tree pick up at Town and Country approved.
  - We cannot do an interactive fundraising event (i.e. a selected fan kicks a field goal kick to win money if made) per WIAA rules.
- **Concessions:**
  - K. Beers with K. Hogan will lead a committee to evaluate possible special event food items at home football games and potentially basketball games. Looking at financials, ease of doing, etc.

- K. Hogan has already walked Town and Country around the stadium property. We agreed to have T&C personnel come to our February meeting.
- J. Hitchings suggested considering doing a different event at each home football game and have them as annual events (i.e. homecoming – Burger Bash, senior night – pulled pork, etc) so that fans come to expect that each year.
- K. Beers and K. Hogan to contact local companies to see if willing to donate food for special food events at NK Athletic events if we were to giving them advertising at the games ( i.e. yard signs as you approach the signs)
- Expiration of foods need to be considered for events.
- Lions willing to let boosters use their Blackstone grills. Boosters may want to consider purchasing one to replace the barbeque grills we currently have.
- Stadium has a mini pizza oven.
- Booster to consider renting a pretzel warmer and pizza warmer.
- J. Pruden has an extra roaster at home that she is donating to boosters.
- **Other**
  - Athletic Medicine Refractometer, a special device to measure moisture for wrestlers, was misplaced. Another was ordered by J. Leslie for \$800 on personal credit card. The question is who should pay for it. J. Pruden to work with district to see if they will pay for it because it is a required for our athletic medicine department to have for wrestling. If district won't pay than boosters has agreed to pay \$100 and athletic medicine and wrestling to pay \$350 each.
