

Dance Attire

So that the faculty may do the best possible job of training and making corrections, and to create the best attitude for learning, we ask that all students adhere to the dress requirements. Please check with your teacher if you have special needs, concerns or questions.

*CLEAN LEOTARDS AND TIGHTS ARE EXPECTED DAILY. The faculty suggests purchasing several leotards and pairs of tights and leaving a clean set in your locker at school.

*LABEL ALL DANCEWEAR. Include your first and last name on clothing to prevent loss or theft.

*NO JEWELRY. Bulky or loose necklaces, bracelets, rings and earrings are not allowed in class.

*ALL DANCERS will need a **nude/flesh toned camisole, sun-back leotard** to wear under costumes and light-colored leotards and a **black leotard** for classes or performances.

*NO STREET CLOTHES ALLOWED. Do not plan to dance in the clothes you wore to school. Do not wear the following items to dance class: leggings, shorts, sweatpants or pajama pants; long or short sleeve t-shirts; camisoles or tank tops

*STUDENTS WITHOUT PROPER ATTIRE GET A "0" FOR THE DAY. Daily points will be deducted for incorrect attire. These points cannot be made up.

Dress Code

BALLET MAJORS

- GIRLS: Solid color classical leotard (lined leotard suggested); pink or skin toned tights and ballet shoes; hair supplies for quick "30 second Ballet -Do". Hair must remain up the entire class. Pointe shoes as appropriate for middle school majors.
- BOYS: solid (white preferred) t-shirt; Black tights or pants fitted at the ankle; Black or white ballet shoes

CONTEMPORARY DANCE MAJORS and MIDDLE SCHOOL DANCE MINORS

- GIRLS: solid colored leotard (lined leotard suggested); skin toned, pink or black tights; hair supplies; Shoes: traditional black jazz shoes (boot style or lace up); undergarments must be concealed. Hair must remain up for the entire class.
- BOYS: solid (white preferred) t-shirt; black ballet tights or pants fitted at the ankle; Shoes: traditional black jazz shoes (boot style or lace up); undergarments must be concealed.

Lockers

LOCKS ARE REQUIRED. Keeping up with dance clothes has been a problem we wish to eliminate. Students that use their locks daily have little or no problems. Students will be sharing a locker and lock with another classmate as there aren't enough lockers to go around.
