ELHI HILL HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM - Students enroll in classes at Bonney Lake High School and/or Sumner High School for half-day and Elhi Hill for half-day. Student transportation is provided to Elhi Hill from BLHS. 2-YEAR AND TECHNICAL COLLEGES

BATES TECHNICAL COLLEGE - Students can earn their high school diploma and Associate Degree simultaneously while enrolled in a career-training program, tuition free. Students must be between 16 and 21 years old and qualify for the training programs

CLOVER PARK TECHNICAL COLLEGE - Northwest Career & Technical High School - Students can earn their high school diploma and vocational skill in a chosen career pathway. Some fees are required - students must provide their own transportation and be 16 years or older.

TACOMA COMMUNITY COLLEGE - Fresh Start Open Doors is a program for 16 - 21 year old students to earn a high school diploma and accumulate college credits at the same time. Tuition and books are free.

It is a quasi-military training and mentoring program for at-risk youth. The program includes educational, life skills and employment training. Students can earn 8 credits at WYA and then return to their home school for graduation completion.
