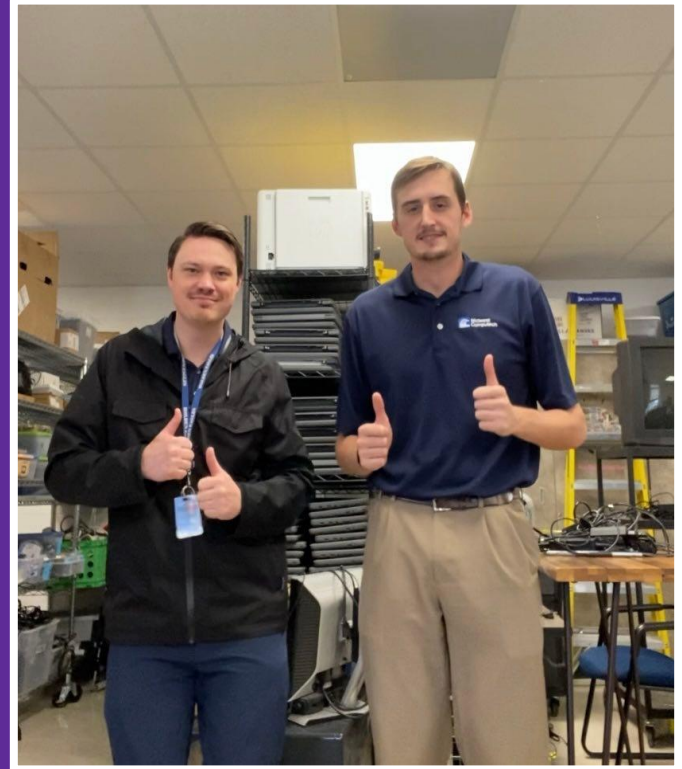

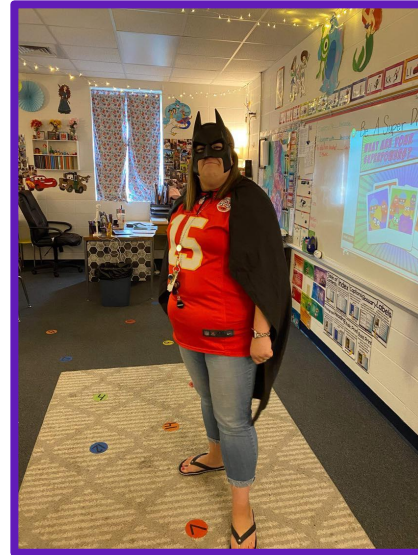

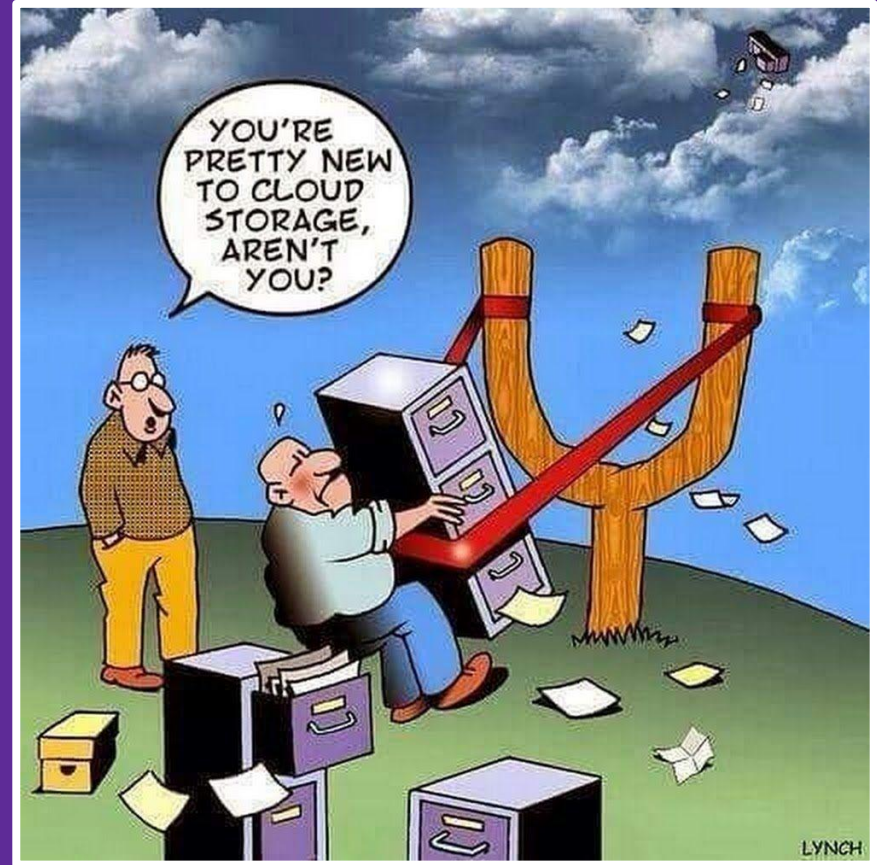




# Work Orders

- Average Number of tickets per day: 14 tickets
- Average time to repair and return a device: 1.13 days
- Average time to reconcile tickets: 6.5 hours

  - Average time to reconcile low priority tickets: 9.5 hours
