What Title Funds Do We Receive?

Title	Allocation
Title I	\$189,524.00
Title IIA	\$41,125.00
Title IVA	\$13,928.00

*All Title money is awarded based on the district's free and reduced rate and overall student population.

What Do We Use These Funds For?

- Title I- Title I funds are used to pay salaries of our reading and math specialists and their teacher assistants.
- Title IIA- Title IIA money is a reward for keeping smaller class sizes. It is only awarded if class sizes in our early grades are kept at a desirable size. These funds pay one of our 1st grade teacher's salary.
- Title IVA- Title IVA money is awarded to schools that may lack adequate funds as an additional support for academic enrichment. These funds are typically used for iReady or increasing our technology supply.

How Are Students Being Served In The Title I Program?

- Students are being served in small groups based on their skill deficits.
- Title teachers provide additional support to students who show characteristics of dyslexia.
- Title teachers provide training and support to classroom teachers through professional development, modeling lessons, analyzing student data, and conducting student incentive programs.
