Technology



Librarian's Role:

- Students bring devices with issues (won't start, broken screens, keys not working, etc.)
- Fill out a technology request form
- Take the Chromebook to Tech Dept.
- Return Chromebook to student

Technology



- This whole process usually also involves checking out a loaner Chromebook from the library.
- Number of Chromebook loaner checkouts ranges from 1 to 16 a day. Average is 6-8.
- Reasons for checking out a Chromebook range from “I left it at home”, “I don’t know where it is”, “It’s dead”, or “It’s broken,” etc.
