- 4. Head Start Partnership

How many families are served?

- 1. Early Childhood Special Education- Morning class 8, Afternoon Class 4
- 2. Eagles Nest- 28
- 3. Parents As Teachers-32
- 4. Head Start 10-20

What is the selection process for each?

- 1. Early Childhood Special Education- Students are screened for developmental delays and if delays are found they are placed on individualized education plans.
- 2. Eagles Nest-There is no selection process.
- 3. Parents As Teachers- There is no selection process. All families who wish to be served are welcome.
- 4. Head Start- Head Start conducts their own screening.

What curriculum is being taught?

- 1. Early Childhood Special Education- Individualized Education Plan Goals and kindergarten readiness goals.
- 2. Eagles Nest- The curriculum is based off the Project Construct Curriculum; however, they use Heggerty (phonemic awareness), Pathways (phonics), and Tang (math) as guiding resources.
- 3. Parents As Teachers- Born to Learn and Foundational Curriculum
- 4. Head Start- Head Start provides their own curriculum and resources.

How is progress monitored and reported to parents?

- 1. Early Childhood Special Education- IEP meetings, 2 yearly parent teacher conference meetings, grade cards, progress reports, and additional meetings as needed
- 2. Eagles Nest- 2 yearly parent teacher conferences, report cards, data notebooks, daily communication logs, additional parent meeting as needed
- 3. Parents As Teachers- In home screenings, and progress is discussed immediately
- 4. Head Start- Friday family visits

How is each program funded?

- 1. Early Childhood Special Education- State funded
- 2. Eagles Nest-State funded for families who qualify, otherwise it is parent pay program
- 3. Parents As Teachers- State funded
- 4. Head Start- Federally funded
