# Homeless- McKinney Vento

- An individual who lacks a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence
- Students who are identified are placed on the free and reduced lunch list
- Students are eligible to receive funds from the homeless set aside fund
- Districts are responsible for the cost of transportation
