# Response to Intervention

Response to Intervention (RTI) is a multi-tier approach to the early identification and support of students with learning and behavior needs. The RTI process begins with high-quality instruction and universal screening of all children.

Struggling learners are provided with interventions at increasing levels of intensity to accelerate their rate of learning. Students that are performing at grade level or beyond are offered enrichment classes.

Progress is closely monitored to assess both the learning rate and level of performance of individual students. Educational decisions about the intensity and duration of interventions are based on individual student response to instruction, data, and teacher input.

# Programs HMS Offers

- Fluency- 1st-7th grade levels - Currently 70 Students
- Comprehension- measured at grade level - Currently 15 Students
- Multiplication- basic facts must score minimum 74% - Currently 17 Students
- Division- basic facts must score minimum 74% - Currently 19 Students
- Vision Intervention Program- All students screened. Currently have 11 students receiving services.
- Enrichment Groups- 9 classes. Examples: Spanish, Bucket Drumming, Writing, Editing, Illustrating your own book, and Coding

# What do we expect our students to learn?

- Core Curriculum
- Basic needs: reading fluency, reading comprehension, multiplication and division basic facts
- Coming Soon– Basic grammar class punctuation, capitalization, etc

# How will we know they are learning?

- Discovery Data

# How will we respond when they don't learn?

- Students are placed by ability. We have students that are reading at a 1st grade level, 2nd, etc.
- We create high, med, and low math groups for multiplication and division
- Students can graduate from a class and move into another before the SOAR session ends.

- Mrs. Fennewald- low multiplication class

How will we respond if they already know it?

- Enrichment
- Students move through enrichment classes such as Spanish and Coding
- Mr. Wakeman- enrichment class
