New Class Offered at HHS

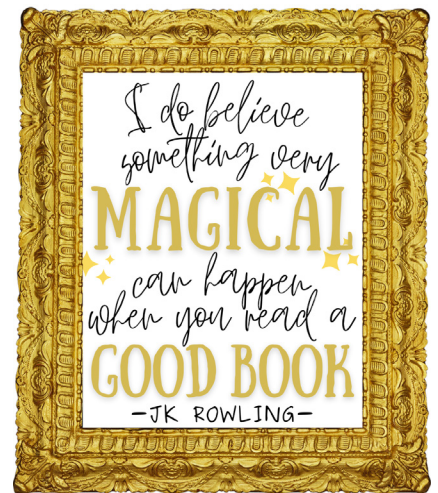
