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### Making Connections in Informational Texts: Effective Questioning

Questions can do more than measure what students know. Appropriately challenging, engaging, and effective questions stimulate peer discussion and encourage students to explore and refine their understanding of key concepts. Coaches discussed the importance of using effective questioning during January's elementary ELA content session. Participants received one-on-one training on strategies to create effective questions through the use of question stems that can be paired with informational texts.
