



MEMBER SCHOOLS: Besteiro, Faulk, Garcia, Lucio, Manzano, Oliveira, Perkins, Stell, Stillman, Vela

1. EACH SCHOOL WILL FIELD A 7TH GRADE / 8TH GRADE “A” Team. The goal for the A team is to have 22 players, and the goal for the B team will be to have 20 players.
2. The 7th & 8th grade “A” Teams will compete for a DISTRICT CHAMPIONSHIP.
3. Both 7th & 8th grade games will be played on Saturday’s. Game order is as follows and will begin at 8:00 a.m. beginning with the 7th grade “B” team, followed by 7th grade “A” team, followed by 8th grade “A” team, followed the “B” team. The 7th grade games will consist of 6 minute quarters while the 8th grade “A” Games will consists of 8 minute quarters. All “B” team games will consist of 6 minute quarters.

Note: The duration of each game, free of injury, is approximately 1.5 hours. All teams are required to report 30 minutes before the game time and the other team should be warming up on the sidelines for their game to begin. A 5-minute break will be allowed for the officials in between games.

4. The football for the 7th grade football used is the youth size, and the 8th grade game will be the OFFICIAL NCAA SIZE.
5. **HOME TEAMS WILL WEAR DARK JERSEYS, UNLESS MUTUALLY AGREED OTHERWISE.**
6. TASO officials will be used for all league games.
7. If a school does not have enough players for a “B”game, you MUST contact the opposing school no later than Wednesday of the game week. The school must then play all of their “B” team players on the “A” team for that week if you do not schedule another team. The opposing school that does not have a team for that week can schedule to play another school. (ex. St. Joe or any other team available.)
8. ***ALL BISD SCHOOLS MUST SUBMIT AN ELIGIBILITY LIST TO THE UIL SCHOOL.** The eligibility list is to be placed in the one drive file under your school created by BESTEIRO. This list must include name, age, and date of birth. **Do not submit social security numbers.** If there are any changes on your original eligibility list, the revised copy with the administrator’s signature, must sent to the UIL School. If there are no changes on your original eligibility list, you do not have to change the list again to the UIL School.

9. **EACH HOME TEAM SHALL DESIGNATE A GAME ADMINISTRATOR, TIMER, GATE PERSONNEL, AND SECURITY. A VISITORS SECTION MUST BE DESIGNATED. HOME TEAM IS ALSO RESPONSIBLE FOR OFFICIALS AND WORKERS SIGN-IN SHEETS.**
10. **NO ADMISSION FEE** for CONTESTS.
11. Athletic Coordinators will email Garcia Middle School (gjrgarces @bisd.us) with the results of Saturdays Games by no later than noon time on Monday.
12. **EVERY ATHLETE THAT IS DRESSED IN UNIFORM AND LISTED ON THE ROSTER MUST PLAY ON THEIR DESIGNATED TEAM. (LOCAL RULE)**
13. **TEAMS WILL EARN 2 POINTS FOR KICKING AN EXTRA POINT, 1 POINT WILL BE EARNED FOR RUNNING OR PASSING FOR THE EXTRA POINT. (LOCAL RULE)**
14. Schools must follow the policies found in the C& CR Manual (UIL), as well as any local policies established in the athletic plan.
15. All protests must be filed with the Chairman within a reasonable time, but not exceeding 4 days after the contest unless it involves eligibility or a rule imposing mandatory penalties.
16. **NO TAUNTING WILL BE TOLERATED BY PLAYERS OR FANS. GAME OFFICIALS AND OR GAME ADMINISTRATION WILL IMPOSE PENALTIES OR HAVE FANS ESCORTED OUT OF THE VENUE.** All coaches should distribute the UIL Parent Handbook to all parents.
17. **TWO GAME SUSPENSION FOR ANY FAN ASKED TO LEAVE TO GAME. ONE GAME SUSPENSION FOR ANY STUDENT-ATHLETE WHO IS EJECTED FROM A GAME OR COMMITS AN ACT THAT IS DEEMED UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT with the exception of TARGETING (will follow UIL Guidelines).**
18. Coaches are expected to follow all UIL Rules and Regulations.
19. **NO METAL CLEATS.**

*** AN INDIVIDUAL MAY PARTICIPATE IN LEAGUE COMPETITION IF HE FOR 7TH GRADE, HAS NOT REACHED His 14TH BIRTHDAY ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1ST, AND HAS NOT ENROLLED IN THE 9TH GRADE. FOR THE 8TH GRADE ATHLETIC COMPETITION, HAS NOT REACHED HIS 15TH BIRTHDAY ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1ST AND HAS NOT ENROLLED IN THE 9TH GRADE.**
