Position Summary

The school is seeking an Upper School (grade 9-12) Track & Field Head Coach for the Spring 2024 season. This position is responsible for coaching and providing direction to student-athletes so that they might achieve a high level of skill as well as an appreciation for discipline, sportsmanship, and teamwork in Track & Field. Candidates must possess knowledge of coaching fundamentals related to Track & Field. The coach will need to drive student-athletes to meets in a small school bus (no CDL required).

Season:

March 1st through late May.

Essential Duties

- Lead Upper School Track & Field team in a positive experience during the season.
- Lead practice 5 or more days/week, approximately 3:45 - 5:30 pm.

- Present at all Track & Field practices and meets.
- Interact thoughtfully and courteously with students, staff, parents, fellow coaches, and officials.
- Communicate with parents and athletes in writing and in person on a weekly basis (at a minimum).
- Instruct and demonstrate skill sets and techniques necessary for individual and team achievement in Track & Field.
- Work with the Athletic Director in preparing practice and match schedules.
- Develop appropriate training programs.
- Arrange transportation for athletic participants.
- Drive (or accompany) student-athletes on the team bus both to and from practices & meets.
- Adhere to all school policies in regard to the collection and disbursement of money, expenses, and receipts.
- Make recommendations regarding the purchase of uniforms, equipment, and supplies.
- Ensure that proper form(s) for all participants (insurance, attendance, medical) are obtained and current.
- Ensure that all student athletes are eligible, and are in good physical condition from the beginning to the end of the season.
- Emphasize sportsmanship and healthy lifestyles.
- Maintain a safe environment and facilities for student athletes at all times.
- Ensure that medical and safety requirements are adhered to.
- Complete injury report for any student injured within 24 hours even if the student athlete does not see a physician.
- Consult with the Athletic Director regarding any off-season training programs.
- Assign duties to all assistant coaches under his/her jurisdiction; including pre-season practice sessions.
- Attend any / all required OSAA coaches meetings.
- Complete all required OSAA coaching certifications.
- Current First Aid/CPR Card (prior to hire).

- Clean driving record and valid driver's license
