At 4:00 p.m., Mr. Seis opened the meeting and greeted everyone before introductions were made.

MINUTES FROM THE LAST MEETING - MR. TODD SEIS

### SCIENCE TECHNOLOGY ENGINEERING AND MATHEMATICS (STEM) BUS - MR. RODNEY SMITH

- Mr. Rodney Smith provided an update on the status and progress of the STEM bus.
  - o Bus Wrap:
    - A picture of the bus with the wrap was shared with the committee.
    - Discussions were made about the design on the wrap and it's placement on the bus.
      - The concern from the committee was:
        - Changing the top of the robot's head
        - Make the STEM letters and logo prominent and more visible

- Enhance the STEM letters so they stand out, have them pop out on the Driver's side
- Make the STEM letters and logo prominent and more visible
- Make the Volusia County Schools logo bigger and more visible
- Volusia STEM should be focal point not the robot
- Logo in the back of the bus.
- Volusia County Schools (VCS) Staff issues:
  - o Adjust the picture to accommodate an awning
  - o On the passenger side there will be a wheelchair lift.
- VCS staff will take back recommendations to the vendor to tweak the design.
- Anticipated wrap cost: \$13,000-25,000.
- STEM Bus Interior and Exterior Modifications:
  - Wood Flooring
  - Ordered generator
  - Building the cage for the generator
  - Removed the exhaust pipes from the left to the right of the bus to fit the generator underneath the left side
  - Converter installation to keep the battery charged
  - Vinyl flooring
  - Floating floor
  - Top of the bus midnight blue bas already been sprayed
  - No seating inside the bus
  - Wheelchair accessibility at the end of the bus
  - Total of 5 32-inch televisions which will be placed along each side of the bus
  - The windows will be covered with White board
  - 155-inch flat screen in the rear of the bus
  - Video matrix with 8 inputs and outputs
  - Sound system with internal/external mic
- Currently under budget at \$52,000.
- Just a regular CDL license is needed to drive the STEM bus because no students are being transported.

### HALF CENT SALES TAX COLLECTION MONTHLY REPORT – Ms. Melissa Alderman

- March collection was: \$5,039,697.70.
- On track to receive the budgeted \$65 million in sales tax for the current Fiscal year.

HALF-CENT SALES TAX MONTHLY FINANCIAL STATEMENTS THROUGH MARCH 31, 2023, FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2023 – MR. TODD SEIS

Ms. Alderman shared the Monthly Financial Report with the committee members.

SUMMARY AND DETAIL REPORT OF HALF-CENT SALES TAX EXPENDITURES FROM INCEPTION THROUGH FEBRUARY 28, 2023, FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2023 (AKA CHECK BOOK) — MR. TODD SEIS

• Budget encumbrances and expenditures for this year fiscal year through April 30th was shared.

FIVE YEAR WORK PLAN - MR. TODD SEIS

- Report as of June 15, 2023, was shared.
- Current year income: \$69 million, which includes other (Investment income) sources of revenue not just the proceeds of the surtax.
- After modifications of projections of revenue, for 2024 we are at \$67.8 million.
- Preliminary Budget will be presented to the Board on June 27, 2023, that includes the Capital Projects Fund Consolidated (Local Capital Improvement Fund, Impact fees and Other Local Funds).
- Tentative Budget will be shared on July 25, 2023.
- Question from Ms. Short:
  - O What are the plans for Read Pattillo Elementary and McInnis Elementary?
  - Dr. Johnson: A Castaldi report was already conducted for McInnis Elementary but not on Read
     Pattillo because the District's initial intent was to close it down.
  - Ms. Short felt like the Board needs to decide on how they will move forward with Read Pattillo and the community needs to be informed of what direction the board will be taking.
  - o Dr. Johnson shared that there will be a presentation on the June 27, 2023, agenda for the west side schools and at a later date a presentation on the east side schools.
- Question from Ms. Short:
  - o Will the Spruce Creek High school discussion be brought back to the Board?
  - o Dr. Johnson: Currently working behind the scenes on that. We are going to look at what is in the best interest of our students, what is on the Five-year Work Plan and re-prioritize.
- Ms. Short also shared that as mentioned by Ms. Bishop before, it would be helpful for the POC to review not just the Capital Five-year Work Plan but also the plan with other funds.
  - O Mr. Seis shared that the Five-year Work Plan with all funds is published in the Preliminary Budget Book as an agenda item for the June 27, 2023, board meeting and is available for all public to view. For the next meeting, he will bring back the overall consolidated Five-year Work Plan which shows the breakdown of Sales Tax, Capital Improvement Funds, Impact Fees, and Local.

### FOLLOW UP ITEMS FROM THE LAST MEETING (S) — Mr. TODD SEIS

### • Facility Condition Index (FCI) (a.k.a. HVAC Report)

- Mr. Young shared that the district has received the report but has not had an opportunity to meet with the company to review the report with them, in order to sort, rank, put numbers to it.
- The update will be provided at the July or August POC meeting.

### Science Classroom

Update will be provided at the July or August POC meeting.

### Sunshine Law/Project Oversight Committee Board Policy

- Board Policy has been proposed to clearly define the roles and responsibility of the Project Oversight Committee.
- o It will provide clarification on what falls under the sunshine law.
- It will allow board members to see what's expected from the committee and what type of feedback they should be expecting to receive.
- General Counsel has already reviewed a draft copy of the proposed policy.
- o Board members have still to review it.
- After their review, it will be shared with the Committee members, and it will go through the normal board policy approval process.

### **PROJECT OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE MEMBER COMMENTS**

#### **Jake Lammers**

- Happy to hear we are under budget on the STEM Bus.
- Looking forward to reviewing the policy.

### Kim Short

• Has concerns about the current condition of Read Pattillo and Spruce Creek High.

### Mitch Aten

- Agreed with the concerns of Ms. Short on Read Pattillo.
- Supportive of the policy and very much needed. Looking forward to reviewing the policy and seeing it does provide more clarity on the roles and responsibilities of the committee and reserving his comments on it till it is shared with the members.
- Mr. Aten asked if any of the committee members were planning to attend the groundbreaking ceremony at Tomoka Elementary.

Ms. Short stated she was planning to attend. Mr. Aten said he might also be able to attend.

### **Todd Seis**

- The primary focus of the policy is on the role of the committee in regard to the sales tax funds
  proceeds. He also shared that the School Board Members enjoy listening to the committee's
  feedback related to the projects from other funding sources.
- The policy could take up to 6 months to go through the process before it is School Board approved.

### **OTHER DISCUSSION ITEMS**

### **Annual Book**

- It needs to be published in September. Ms. Bishop is helping with gathering member comments for the book.
- Mr. Aten shared that the policy might help guide with what is added to the Annual report.

### City of Deltona – Ron Young

- City of Deltona has recently spent a lot of money building a reclaim water facility and they have asked the school district to connect to their system. They would like to connect Pine Ridge High and Heritage Middle.
- Budgeted amount is about \$250,000 per school because those systems irrigate all of our athletic fields.

Question: Does the committee consider this as an appropriate use of half-cent sales tax funds?
