Difference Between MS & HS

Grades vs. Credits

Bad grades need to be made up (D/Fs) Ds don't count for college & need to be made up: Summer Sch, Night school, Comm. College, etc.

Semester vs. Quarter System

- Grades don't start over at each quarter: quarter grade is a stepping stone to a semester grade
- Quarter grades (1st quarter and 3rd quarter). Not posted to transcript
- Semester grades (1st & 2nd sem). Official grade posts to transcript!

Mark your calendar:

Sept. 8 – Q1 <u>Progress</u> Report Grading period ends

Oct. 13 – Q1 Grading period ends

Nov.10 – Q2 <u>Progress</u> Report Grading period ends

 Dec. 22 – 1st Semester Grading period ends (official grade put on transcripts)

Academic Time

- Monitor progress on a regular basis
- Monitor Google Classroom: notifications, assignments, etc.
- Stay organized: Student Planner with all assignments and test dates
- Utilize After School Tutoring (TBA):
 - Wilcox Tutoring (M-Thur/after school)
 - <u>www.paper.co</u> (free 24/7 tutoring for 6-12 gr)
- Contact teachers directly, if any concerns!
- Check syllabuses for teacher's policies
- Use GMail accounts for updates and communication with your counselor!




