Description: We will be partnering with PPM to serve in Anchorage, Wasilla, Palmer, Soldotna, Homer, Talkeetna, or Fairbanks (site to be determined based on need). If a house cannot be found, we have the option to sleep at one of the churches which would probably be on air mattresses. One day we will spend exploring the last frontier! This will involve walking, hiking, possibly some climbing, a boat ride and/or a train ride so be ready for an active day.
