

SAISD Extra-Curricular Transfers

A San Angelo ISD student's residency for extra-curricular eligibility will be determined based upon the campus the student **enters or has entered** during his or her 9th grade year. That campus will be considered the student's home campus. If a student wishes to transfer from one high school to another in SAISD and continues to reside in the same attendance zone, the student **will not** be eligible to participate in athletics for the remainder of the time that he or she is in high school. Therefore, if a student desires to live in one attendance zone and transfers to the other, he or she **will not** be eligible for UIL activities.

A student **may** appeal this procedure by filing a waiver. The waiver application along with the UIL "Previous Athletic Participation Form" must be submitted to the Executive Director of Athletics at 1621 University, San Angelo, TX 76904. The waiver will be considered by a district committee composed of the Athletic Director and the Athletic Coordinator from each high school. The waiver must prove that the circumstance for which the appeal is being filed for was involuntary and or an unavoidable circumstance. The decision of the committee is final.

If the student's family moves into the new school's attendance zone, then UIL guidelines will apply. (see below)

Possible Exceptions:

- If a student is requesting a transfer and wishes to participate in an extra-curricular activity that is not offered on the home campus, then eligibility to participate in those activities could be granted. Example: swimming and gymnastics are not offered at Lake View. Students will need to go through the waiver process. If the transfer is granted, a student can participate in those sports and no others.
- If the family moves into the other attendance zone, eligibility is not guaranteed. UIL rules will be followed regarding the move. The UIL "Previous Athletic Participation Form" must be completed and the District Executive Committee will rule. If the DEC determines the move was for athletic reasons, then eligibility will be denied for one calendar year (UIL rule). UIL procedures do allow a student to appeal the DEC decision. All appeals are heard in front of the UIL State Executive Committee.
