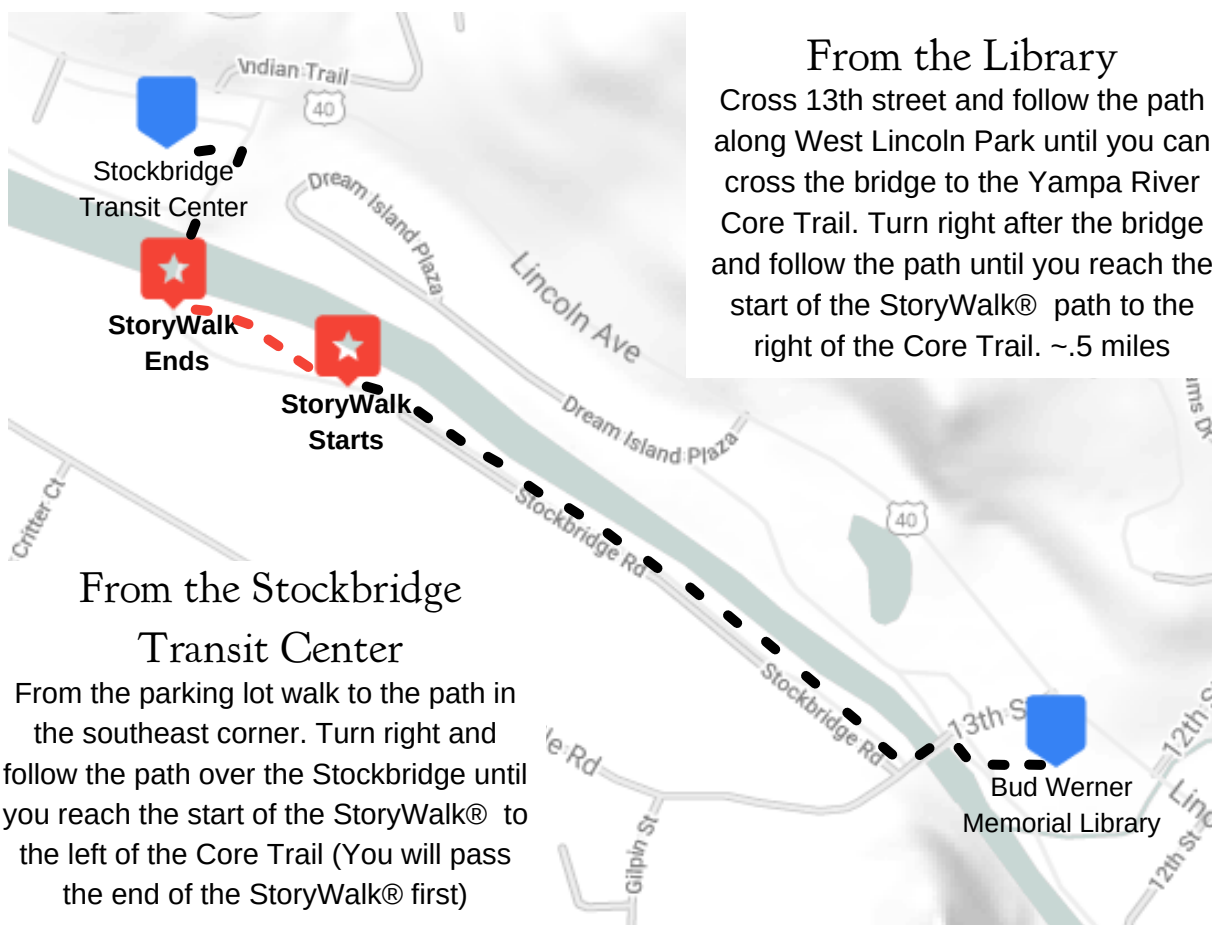

From the Library

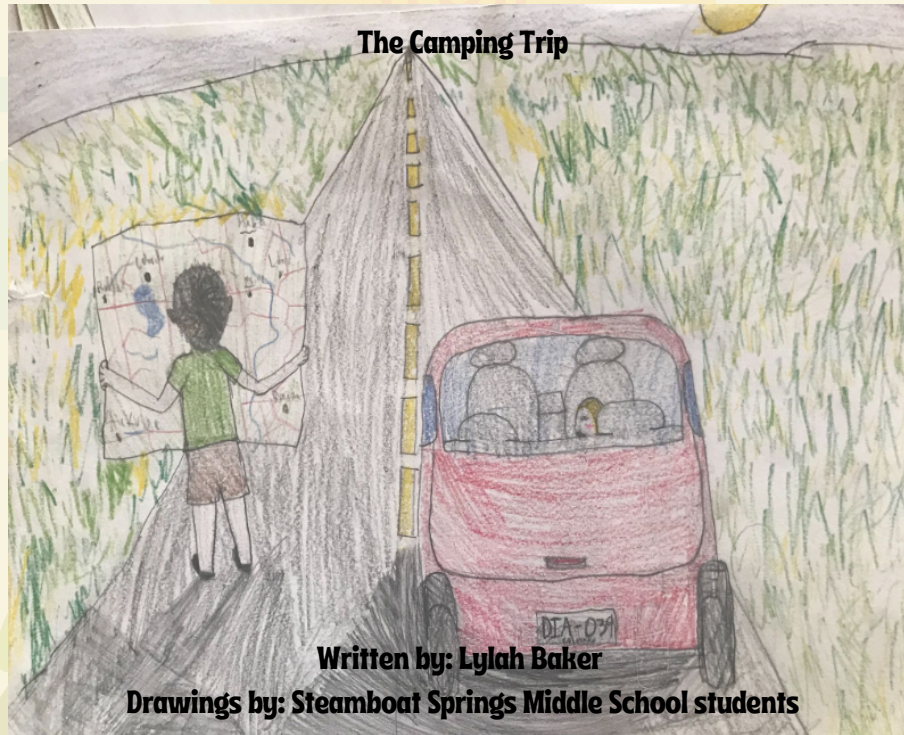
Cross 13th street and follow the path along West Lincoln Park until you can cross the bridge to the Yampa River Core Trail. Turn right after the bridge and follow the path until you reach the start of the StoryWalk® path to the right of the Core Trail. ~.5 miles

From the Stockbridge Transit Center

From the parking lot walk to the path in the southeast corner. Turn right and follow the path over the Stockbridge until you reach the start of the StoryWalk® to the left of the Core Trail (You will pass the end of the StoryWalk® first)
