

# Health Check-Up and Magnus Health FAQ

## **Is the Health Check-up mandatory for everyone?**

Yes. The Ministry of Health's Joint Circular No:13/2016/TTLT-BYT-BGDDT, PART 3 – HEALTH SPECIALTY EXAMINATION requires an annual health check by a physician.

## **How do I submit the health check-up form?**

You can upload the health check-up form at any time to Magnus Health. You will find detailed instructions on accessing your Magnus Health account in this [instructional video](#) and this [Magnus Health Tutorial PDF](#). Please **do not submit paper copies** to our Health Office.

## **My child had a check-up already, but we used another form. Can I use it?**

Yes. If your child's health form is signed by a medical provider and covers the requirements in the [SSIS Health Form](#), we will accept it.

## **When is the health form due?**

The health check-up is due by December 1, 2023. **If your child requires an emergency action plan for a health condition or has food or environmental allergies, you must inform the health office before the start of school.**

## **What is Magnus Health?**

Magnus Health is a secure and encrypted student medical records system. It employs the highest level of secure storage of centralized medical records. Further, it allows the school to create tiered access to your child's sensitive health data, eliminating the need for printed or emailed copies, which are much more vulnerable to the exposure of sensitive information.

## **What are the benefits of Magnus Health?**

Encrypted data, no need for paper records, tiered access, quick and accurate access in one central location in the event of an emergency

## **Who has access to my child's records?**

As with PowerSchool's health records, only persons/trip partners at the school who have legitimate reasons within their role for teaching and learning, counseling, or in the health office will have access on a needs-only basis.
