The Calcasieu Parish School Board Meeting was held at 3310 Broad Street, Lake Charles, Louisiana, on Tuesday, January 10, 2023.

The meeting was called to order by Russell Castille, Vice-President. The prayer and pledge were led by Glenda Gay.

The Honorable Judge G. Michael Canaday administered the Oath of Office to all Board Members. Mr. Castille called a short recess in order for the oaths to be signed. Board Members introduced family members in attendance.

Mr. Breaux nominated Mr. Castille as president for 2023; Mr. Hardesty seconded. Mr. Castille was voted unanimously as the CPSB President for 2023. Mr. Roberts, with a second by Mr. Hardesty, nominated Mr. Tarver as vice-president. Mrs. Gay nominated Mr. Wallace as vice-president. Mr. Wallace thanked Mrs. Gay, but declined the nomination. Mr. Tarver was voted CPSB Vice-President on a unanimous vote.

## **SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT**

Dr. LaFargue gave the following report:

I. You have each received your Head Start report:

### **Program Governance**

**Program Operations**

- Policy Council members and Head Start Social Workers traveled to Dallas for the National Head Start Parent and Family Engagement Conference. Policy council members and social workers who traveled to Dallas shared information received at the Policy Council December retreat.
- Head Start sites received Christmas donations from Helping Hands for the Holidays, Toys for Tots, and Save the Children.

2. You have each received the school population report, showing numbers from the end of August compared to the numbers at the end of December for this school year.

3. I would like to report our December, 2022 sales tax numbers for our general fund which show collections at \$172,584 or 1.2 % below budget for the 6<sup>th</sup> month of the 2022-2023 fiscal year.

- Collections are \$1,069,455 or 7.2% below collections for the same month last year.
- After 6 months, collections are \$5,420,793 or 6.3% above budget and \$854,085 or 0.9% below the same period last year.

4. Hurricane Information: The summary is at your seating area. For this item, Mr. Bourne will provide a very general overview of an update related to hurricane recovery at this time.

5. We participate every year in the Kiwanis Coats for Kids Project and I'm very happy to report the following information we received from Steve Ek of the Kiwanis Club of Lake Charles, that 1,016 coats were distributed to 10 different agencies that serve those in need in Calcasieu and Beauregard parishes.

6. You have information at your seating area regarding the annual LSBA convention here in Lake Charles on March 7-9. Please let Peggy know if you would like to be registered.

Please put the morning of February 16<sup>th</sup> on your calendar, as we will have our orientation for new board members and important information from staff for all board members, from 8:30-10:00. This will be followed by Emergent Method with Strategic Planning information from 10:00-Noon. More information will follow, the meeting will be here in the board room.

And with that said, staff would like to welcome the new board members and returning board members. We look forward to your stewardship and CPSB's continued growth!

We have a couple of items of celebratory news. The first is our district has received the Louisiana Department of Education's highest award – The Louisiana Models of Excellence Award.

The Louisiana Models of Excellence initiative was created in an effort to acknowledge, honor, and spotlight schools serving as exemplary models for implementing the Department's Believe to Achieve educational priorities that leads to the advancement of student success.

The LDOE's award will recognize and highlight Lake Charles Boston Academy's Virtual Instruction program on February 9<sup>th</sup> from 11:30 until 1 p.m. The presentation and event will be held at LCBA and a large faction of LDOE staff including Dr. Cade Brumley will be in attendance. Dr. Brumley is also inviting other districts to witness this new initiative. On February 9<sup>th</sup>, we will celebrate the 3 pillars that the LDOE recognized for Calcasieu: Innovation, partnerships, and resilience.

The second item of celebration is that annually the ESL Department submits a very detailed plan to the LDOE documenting all we do as a district to support the English Learners in grades K-12. We are proud to announce that CPSB has been classified as an Exemplary School System in regard to the work we do with English Learners.

And lastly, speaking of partnerships, This Saturday McNeese State Basketball will honor our CPSB teachers with Teacher Appreciation Day. Any teacher, faculty or staff member in the parish will be honored with free admission to McNeese State's basketball double header, featuring the women's and men's basketball programs. The Ordinance was approved and signed by the President, attested by the Secretary, and provides as follows:

**ORDINANCE**

**CALCASIEU PARISH SCHOOL BOARD  
MASTER SALES AND USE TAX ORDINANCE OF 2023**

TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL REVENUE FOR THE PARISH SCHOOL BOARD OF CALCASIEU PARISH, LOUISIANA, AND ITS SUBORDINATE TAXING DISTRICTS, BY LEVYING A TAX UPON THE SALE AT RETAIL, THE USE, THE LEASE OR RENTAL, THE CONSUMPTION AND THE STORAGE FOR USE OR CONSUMPTION OF TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY AND UPON THE SALE OF SERVICES AS PRESENTLY DEFINED IN LA .R.S. 47:301 TO LA. R.S. 47:316, INCLUSIVE, AND LA. R.S. 47:337.1 TO 47:337.102, INCLUSIVE; DEFINING CERTAIN TERMS; LEVYING AND PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT, COLLECTION, PAYMENT AND DISPOSAL OF SUCH TAXES; PROVIDING FOR AN ADEQUATE REMEDY AT LAW; DEFINING VIOLATIONS OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES THEREFOR; PROVIDING FOR RULES AND REGULATIONS AND ENFORCEMENT OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE AND COLLECTION OF THE TAXES LEVIED THEREBY; PROVIDING THAT ANY PART OF THIS ORDINANCE WHICH MAY BE HELD INVALID OR UNCONSTITUTIONAL SHALL NOT AFFECT OR IMPAIR ANY OTHER PART HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

**WHEREAS**, the Calcasieu Parish School Board and its subordinate sales tax districts duly created by the Calcasieu Parish School Board (collectively the "Board") currently levies and collects sales and use taxes pursuant to four (4) individual previously adopted ordinances (collectively, the "Previous Sales Tax Ordinances"), to-wit:

- (i) Calcasieu Parish Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 1968 – 1%;
- (ii) Calcasieu Parish School Board District #2 Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 1992 – ½%;
- (iii) Calcasieu Parish Sales and Use Tax Ordinance #4 of 1995 – ½%; and
- (iv) Calcasieu Parish School Board Salary #2 Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 2015 – ½ of 1%;

**WHEREAS**, in order to establish consistency and uniformity in collection, enforcement and administration of the Previous Sales Tax Ordinances, described above, presently levied and collected by the Board, and any future sales tax levies, it is the desire of the Board to adopt a single master sales and use tax ordinance, which ordinance shall exclusively control the levy, imposition, collection, enforcement and administration of all sales and use taxes due to the Board and/or its subordinate taxing districts;

**WHEREAS**, the Board's Tax Director (the "Collector") has proposed, upon recommendation by outside counsel, adoption of a Master Sales and Use Tax Ordinance, for promotion of consistent and uniform administration, collection and enforcement procedures and provisions;

**WHEREAS**, the Board recognizes that such action is deemed in its best interests, as well as the best interests of the residents and taxpayers of Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana, that the following Master Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 2023 be adopted by the Board, subject only to such amendments and modifications as may be required by legislation adopted annually by the Louisiana Legislature;

**WHEREAS**, the Board desires to amend and reenact "Calcasieu Parish Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 1968", as amended, into "Master Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 2023" for the purpose of creating a uniform local ordinance by which all existing levies, enacted by the Board, shall be administered provided, however, that nothing herein shall be construed to alter in any manner the original levy, the tax rate, longevity, or disposition of proceeds from the sales and uses taxes described therein;

**WHEREAS**, the Board desires to amend and reenact "Calcasieu Parish Sales and Use Tax Ordinance # 4 of 1995", as amended, into "Master Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 2023" for the purpose of creating a uniform local ordinance by which all existing levies enacted by the Board, shall be administered provided, however, that nothing herein shall be construed to alter in any manner the original levy, the tax rate, longevity, or disposition of proceeds from the sales and use taxes described therein;

**WHEREAS**, the Board desires to amend and reenact "Calcasieu Parish School Board District #2 Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 1992", as amended, into "Master Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 2023" for the purpose of creating a uniform local ordinance by which all existing levies enacted by the Board, shall be administered provided, however, that nothing herein shall be construed to alter in any fashion the original levy, the tax rate, longevity, or disposition of proceeds from the sales and use taxes described therein; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board desires to amend and reenact "Calcasieu Parish School Board Sales and Use Tax Ordinance Salary #2 of 2015", into "Master Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 2023" for the purpose of creating a uniform local ordinance by which all existing levies enacted by the Board, shall be administered provided, however, that nothing herein shall be construed to alter in any fashion the original levy, the tax rate, longevity, or disposition of proceeds from the sales and use taxes described therein;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Calcasieu Parish School Board, governing authority of the public school system of Calcasieu Parish, State of Louisiana, as follows:

The Board does hereby ordain, decree, and establish complete consistency and uniformity in all aspects of the levy, imposition, collection, and enforcement of all sales and use taxes previously approved by the electorate and currently levied by the Previous Sales Tax Ordinances. All Previous Sales Tax Ordinances are hereby amended and supplemented, to the extent necessary to achieve consistency and uniformity with this Master Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 2023. It is the express intention and purpose of the Board that the provisions of this Master Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 2023 supersede and prevail in the event of any conflict between this Master Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 2023 and the Previous Sales Tax Ordinances. Any and all conflicts existing between the terms and provisions of this Master Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 2023 and the Previous Sales Tax Ordinances, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Effective on February 1, 2023, the terms and provisions of this Master Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 2023 shall exclusively control the levy, imposition, collection, enforcement, and administration of all sales and use taxes due to the Board and/or its subordinate taxing districts, specifically inclusive of the Previous Sales Tax Ordinances. The levy, imposition, collection, enforcement, and administration of all sales and use taxes described within the Previous Sales Tax Ordinances shall be exclusively governed by the provisions of this Master Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 2023.

The levy, imposition, collection, enforcement, and administration of the sales and use taxes originally levied pursuant to the provisions of the Previous Sales Tax Ordinances shall continue in full force and effect through January 31, 2023, when the same are superseded by the provisions of this Master Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 2023.

**SECTION 1. Definitions.** As used in this Ordinance, all terms, words, and phrases shall have the meaning ascribed to them in La. R.S. 47:301, *et. seq.*, as modified or supplemented by the *Uniform Local Sales Tax Code*, 47:337.1, *et. seq.*:

A. **"Collector"** shall mean the Calcasieu Parish School Board's Tax Director and his/her duly authorized agents and assistants thereof designated by the School Board of the Parish of Calcasieu, State of Louisiana, for the purpose of collecting the sales and use taxes originally levied pursuant to the Previous Sales Tax Ordinances and now levied pursuant to this Ordinance, as well as any future sales tax levies of the Board and its subordinate taxing districts (the "Tax").

B. **"Governing Authority"** shall mean and include the School Board of Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana.

C. **"Ordinance"**, as used herein, whether "the Ordinance" or "this Ordinance", shall refer exclusively to this Master Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 2023 *and any subsequent amendments thereto*.

## **SECTION 2. Imposition of Tax LSA-R.S. 47:302**

**I-(A).** That there is hereby relieved, from and after January 31, 2023, for the purposes set out in Calcasieu Parish Sale and Use Tax Ordinance of 1968, a tax upon the sale at retail, the use, the consumption, the distribution and the storage for use or consumption in the Parish of each item or article of tangible personal property, as defined herein, the relevy of said tax to be as follows:

- (i) At the rate of one (1%) percent of the sales price of each item or article of tangible personal property when sold at retail in the Parish, the tax to be computed on gross sales for the purpose of remitting the amount of tax due the Board and to include each and every retail sale.
- (ii) At the rate of one (1%) percent of the costs price of each item or article of tangible personal property when the same is not sold, but is used, consumed distributed or stored for use or consumption in the Parish, provided there shall be no duplication of the tax.

**I-(B).** There is hereby relieved a tax upon the lease or rental within the Parish of each item of tangible personal property, as defined herein, the relevy of said tax to be as follows:

- (i) At the rate of one (1%) percent of the gross proceeds derived from the lease or rental of tangible personal property, as defined herein, where the lease or rental of such property is an established business, or a part of an established business, or the same is incidental or germane to the

said business.

- (ii) At the rate of one (1%) percent of the monthly lease or rental price paid by the lessee or rentee or contracted or agreed to be paid by lessee or rentee to the owner of the tangible personal property.

**I-(C).** There is hereby relieved a tax upon all sales of services, as herein defined, in this Parish, at the rate of one (1%) percent of the amounts paid or charged for such services.

**I-(D).** The sales and use tax originally relieved pursuant to Calcasieu Parish Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 1968 is to be relieved perpetually, and the proceeds thereof may be utilized by the Board for those purposes set forth in Calcasieu Parish Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 1968.

**II-(A).** That there is hereby levied, from and after January 31, 2023, for the purposes set out in Calcasieu Parish School Board District# 2 Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 1992 a tax upon the sale at retail, the use, the consumption, the distribution and the storage for use or consumption in the Parish of each item or article of tangible personal property, as defined herein, the relevy of said tax to be as follows:

- (i) At the rate of one-half of one ( $\frac{1}{2}$  %) percent of the sales price of each item or article of tangible personal property when sold at retail in the Parish, the tax to be computed on gross sales for the purpose of remitting the amount of tax due the Board and to include each and every retail sale.
- (ii) At the rate of one-half of one ( $\frac{1}{2}$  %) percent of the costs price of each item or article of tangible personal property when the same is not sold, but is used, consumed distributed or stored for use or consumption in the Parish, provided there shall be no duplication of the tax.

**II-(B).** There is hereby relieved a tax upon the lease or rental within the Parish of each item of tangible personal property, as defined herein, the relevy of said tax to be as follows:

- (i) At the rate of one-half of one ( $\frac{1}{2}$  %) percent of the gross proceeds derived from the lease or rental of tangible personal property, as defined herein, where the lease or rental of such property is an established business, or a part of an established business, or the same is incidental or germane to the said business.

- (ii) At the rate of one-half of one ( $\frac{1}{2}$  %) percent of the monthly lease or rental price paid by the lessee or rentee or contracted or agreed to be paid by lessee or rentee to the owner of the tangible personal property.

**II-(C).** There is hereby relieved a tax upon all sales of services, as herein defined, in this Parish, at the rate of one-half of one ( $\frac{1}{2}$  %) percent of the amounts paid or charged for such services.

**II-(D).** The sales and use tax originally relieved pursuant to Calcasieu Parish School Board District #2 Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 1992 was relieved for multiple ten (10) year periods or through January 31, 2023, and the proceeds thereof may be utilized by the Board for those purposes set forth in Calcasieu Parish School Board District #2 Sales and Use Tax Ordinance of 1992.

**III-(A).** That there is hereby relieved, from and after January 31, 2023, for the purposes set out in Calcasieu Parish Sales and Use Tax Ordinance # 4 of 1995 a tax upon the sale at retail, the use, the consumption, the distribution and the storage for use or consumption in the Parish of each item or article of tangible personal property, as defined herein, the relevy of said tax to be as follows:

- (i) At the rate of one-half of one ( $\frac{1}{2}$  %) percent of the sales price of each item or article of tangible personal property when sold at retail in the Parish, the tax to be computed on gross sales for the purpose of remitting the amount of tax due the Board and to include each and every retail sale.
- (ii) At the rate of one-half of one ( $\frac{1}{2}$  %) percent of the costs price of each item or article of tangible personal property when the same is not sold, but is used, consumed distributed or stored for use or consumption in the Parish, provided there shall be no duplication of the tax.

**III-(B).** There is hereby relieved a tax upon the lease or rental within the Parish of each item of tangible personal property, as defined herein, the relevy of said tax to be as follows:

- (i) At the rate of one-half of one ( $\frac{1}{2}$  %) percent of the gross proceeds derived from the lease or rental of tangible personal property, as defined herein, where the lease or rental of such property is an established business, or a part of an established business, or the same is incidental or germane to the said business.

- (ii) At the rate of one-half of one ( $\frac{1}{2}$  %) percent of the monthly lease or rental price paid by the lessee or rentee or contracted or agreed to be paid by lessee or rentee to the owner of the tangible personal property.

**III-(C).** There is hereby relieved a tax upon all sales of services, as herein defined, in this Parish, at the rate of one-half of one ( $\frac{1}{2}$  %) percent of the amounts paid or charged for such services.

**III-(D).** The sales and use tax originally relieved pursuant to Calcasieu Parish Sales and Use Tax Ordinance # 4 of 1995, at the rate of one-half of one ( $\frac{1}{2}$  %) percent, is relieved through September 30, 2015, and the proceeds thereof may be utilized by the Board for those purposes set forth in Calcasieu Parish Sales and Use Tax Ordinance# 4 of 1995.

**IV-(A).** That there is hereby levied, from and after January 31, 2023, for the purposes and for the period set out in Calcasieu Parish School Board Sales and Use Tax Ordinance Salary #2 of 2015, a tax upon the sale at retail, the use, the consumption, the distribution, and the storage for use or consumption in the Parish of each item or article of tangible personal property as defined herein, the relevy of said tax to be as follows:

- (i) At the rate of one-half of one ( $\frac{1}{2}$  %) percent of the sales price of each item or article of tangible personal property when sold at retail in the Parish, the tax to be computed on gross sales for the purpose of remitting the amount of tax due the Board and to include each and every retail sale.
- (ii) At the rate of one-half of one percent ( $\frac{1}{2}$  %) of the costs price of each item or article of tangible personal property when the same is not sold, but is used, consumed, distributed, or stored for use or consumption in the Parish, provided there shall be no duplication of the tax.

**IV-(B).** There is hereby relieved a tax upon the lease or rental within the Parish of each item of tangible personal property, as defined herein; the relevy of said tax to be as follows:

- (i) At the rate of one-half of one ( $\frac{1}{2}$  %) percent of the gross proceeds derived from the lease or rental of tangible personal property, as defined herein, where the lease or rental of such property is an established business, or a part of an established business, or the same is incidental or germane to the said business.
