# 10<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Schedule and Parking Pass Pickup

12<sup>th</sup> graders can come up to the building on August 14<sup>th</sup> between 8:30am – 10:30am. 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> graders can come to the building between 11:00am – 2:00pm. Students in these grade levels can come anytime in their respective window of time. If students have a school sponsored conflict or other work obligation during their scheduled time, then they can come at another grade levels scheduled time. Students will pick up their schedule, purchase a parking permit if necessary, turn in any student privilege forms, and enroll in the fingerscanning software if they are not already enrolled.

#### Freshmen and New Student Orientation

Freshmen and new student orientation will take place on August 15<sup>th</sup>. Students with last names A – K will have their orientation meeting at 9:00am. Students with last names L – Z will have their orientation meeting at 10:30am. We will begin in the PAC with a presentation by administrators and counselors. Students will also receive their class schedule and Chromebooks, and get enrolled in our fingerscanning software. The building will be open for students to find their locker, their classrooms, and get accustomed to navigating the halls of WHS. Parents should attend this event with their freshman student if they are able. Not only will we be welcoming our newest Demons to the High School, but we will also go over important information for both students and parents.

Westlake High School does not have supply lists for students. Any specific supply needs will come from your student's classroom teacher.

## **School Hours**

The Westlake High School main entrance will open at 6:30am on school days. If your student needs to be dropped off early, then they are welcome to sit in the Rotunda until school starts. Students are permitted to leave the Rotunda and enter the academic hallways at 7:30am unless they have a specific meeting to attend prior to that time. Students are not permitted to remain on the campus after 3:30pm unless they are participating in an after-school activity.

## **Parking Permits**

Parking permits will be sold to students on the schedule pickup days. In order for a student to park on the campus, they must have a Westlake High School parking permit. The cost of a permit is \$30. Students can pay with cash or a check (made payable to Westlake Board of Education) when they come to purchase their pass. Parents and students must fill out the parking permit Google form, as well as bring the accompanying documents, in order to obtain a permit. Please note that having a parking permit enters you into the random drug testing pool. This means that you will have to consent to the policy, and can be subject to random drug testing at any time throughout the school year. Click here for the online parking permit form.

# **Junior/Senior Student Privilege**

We will be continuing the Student Privilege program this year for Juniors and Seniors. Students may have Late Arrival (coming in for 2nd period), Early Dismissal (leaving 11th period), or Lunch Privilege and are permitted to leave the campus during that time. Students may indicate their preference, but decisions will be made based on scheduling. This privilege may be lost if the student fails to follow school rules and/or privilege guidelines. Juniors are only permitted one privilege period per semester and seniors are permitted no more than two privilege periods per semester.

In order to be enrolled in this privilege, Junior and Senior students will need to fill out the Student Privilege form. Any student with a privilege period will need to come to school on the first day and attend a brief rules meeting during their privilege period. (For example, if you have 1<sup>st</sup> period privilege on your schedule then you will come to school for first period on the first day of school to attend the meeting then will be dismissed for privilege) The meeting will take place in the PAC. At the meeting you will turn in your signed Privilege form. You will not be permitted to go on privilege without your signed form.

# **CCP Student Privilege**

CCP classes offered at Westlake High School will not meet daily. Oftentimes CCP classes meet two to three days per week. On days when the CCP class is not in session, students may choose to remain in the building and be placed in a study hall or leave the building (privilege). If a student chooses the privilege option, they MUST leave the building when their CCP class is not in session. In order to be enrolled in this privilege, CCP students will need to fill out the CCP Student Privilege form.

# **Medication & Drug Policy Information**

Students are not permitted to possess prescription or over-the-counter medication on school grounds. The appropriate form must be filed with the school nurse before the student will be allowed to begin taking any medication during school hours, or to use an inhaler to self-administer asthma medication. Such forms must be filed annually and as necessary for any change in the medication.
