- Approval of [JCTC ENG 101 & 102](#) - After much discussion, approved by consensus.
 - We currently have 14 juniors in JCTC's ENC 96 course with Ms. Skillern. They were chosen for this Tier III intervention course due to poor assessment scores in prior years along with deficient skills. This course qualifies as their junior English credit towards graduation. Many of these students do not have the ACT scores to be considered transition ready.
 - ENC 96 is part of JCTC's A2C or Accelerate to College program. By passing ENC 96 as a junior, this group of students will be automatically eligible for admission to JCTC's ENG 101 & 102. Many wouldn't be eligible for our other English dual credit offering due to their ACT scores. They would take these two courses, one each semester, in lieu of English IV.
