We are incredibly grateful to the St. Helens community for their continued support and commitment to our schools.

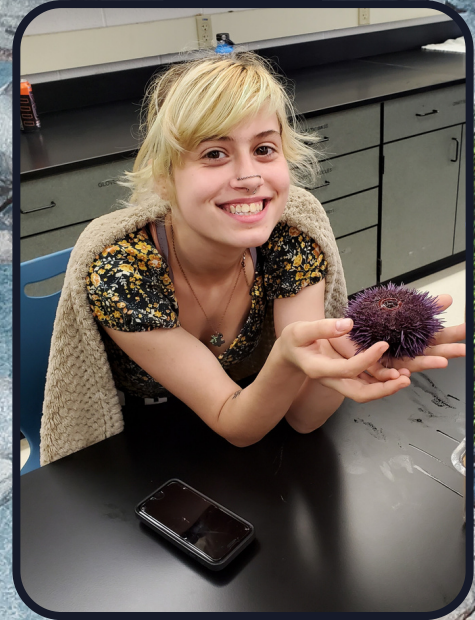
