


Whole Child Supports Track One: Wraparound Services Overview

The Wraparound Services Initiative is a response to the growing need across the state to address non-academic barriers to student learning. By developing and coordinating services and supports via a program, service, or center, school leaders, school coordinators, and team members (the school leadership team) will learn the key steps of the wraparound sequence.

Through coaching, school-based staff develop sustainable, wraparound practices, including mental health, while ensuring school improvement teams align and embed wraparound services and supports into school plans. The coaching process utilizes the eight phases from the wraparound sequence which are integrated into Georgia's System of Continuous Improvement.



Coaching on the Wraparound Sequence steps will include the following:

- Systems and structures (the "what") that must be in place for sustained improvement in student outcomes,
- Problem-solving model (the "how") to provide a clear process for identifying improvement needs,
- Planning for improvement,
- Implementing,
- Monitoring, and
- Evaluating the improvement efforts.
