Please remember, <u>no binders, pencil sharpeners, or mechanical pencils</u> unless your child's teacher has specifically requested these items. All 3rd and 4th grade students will be provided an assignment planner in the fall. Gym shoes will not be required to be kept at school this year. However, your child <u>will be required to wear tennis shoes</u> on their class gym days.
