- Knowledge of state guidance regarding physical restraint and seclusion.
- Experience of working with young adults ages 18-26.
- Experience with Secondary Transition processes and services.
- Experience assisting students with Employment skills, Independent living, and community involvement.

Responsibilities:

Develops meaningful IEPs and transition plans for students with moderate cognitive impairments, in a self-contained program located in a local district. Provides a full curriculum in the least restrictive environment. Instructs students and assists in developing functional academics, social interactions and life-skills utilizing various research-based resources. Plans curricula and prepares lessons and other instructional materials to meet the individual needs of students. Coordinates and conducts student-centered meetings involving students, parents, agencies and support staff. Responsible for case management activities. Embraces and supports Heritage Southwest Intermediate School District's strategic plan.

Physical Demands and Work Environment:

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand, walk, sit, talk, see and hear. The employee is frequently required to stoop, kneel, crouch, crawl and reach with hands and arms. The employee may occasionally lift and/or move up to 60 pounds or more. Occasional travel may be required. Noise levels are typically moderate.
