# Dear Academy Families,

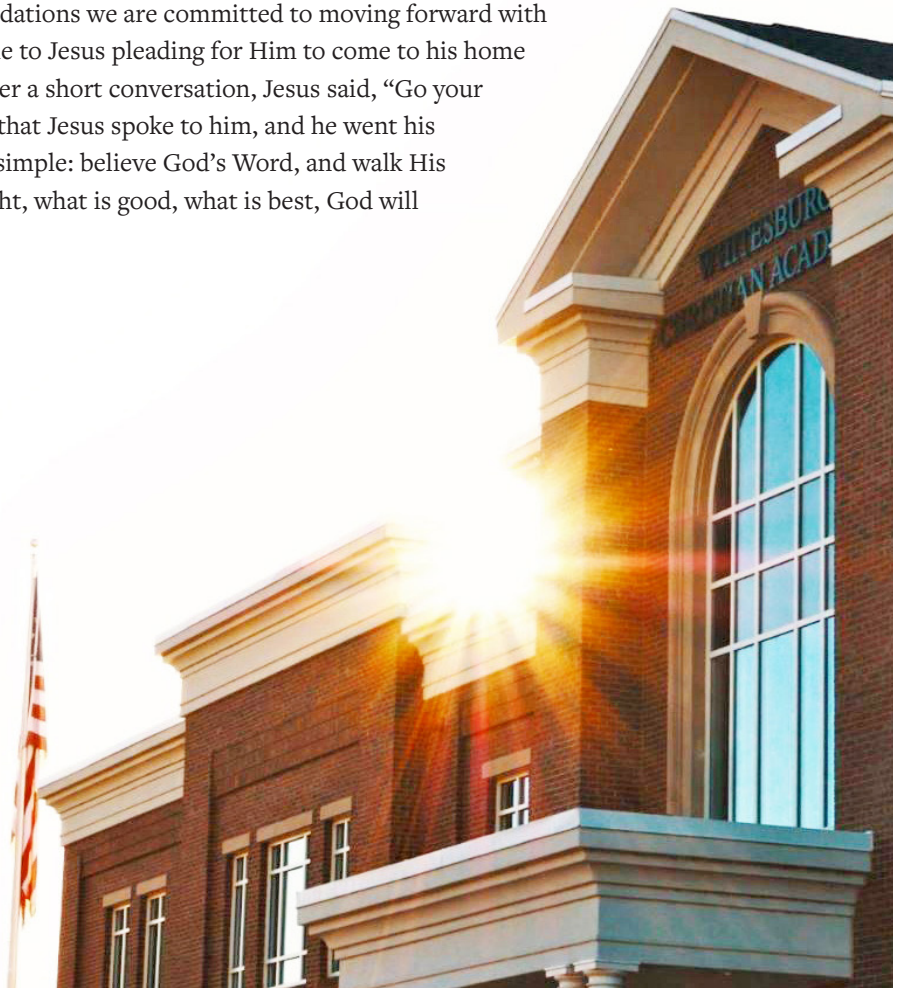
On behalf of the staff and administration of The Academy, I want to greet you in hopes that you have had a great summer and that you and your family are healthy and well. It seems summer break is shorter every year. I was happy to spend a week in Hawaii with my wife in June for a much-needed break. I was privileged to spend two weeks with students and chaperones on our SLU 201 and 301 trips. We all were blessed with amazing speakers and life changing visits to places like Omaha Beach in Normandy, France. I am always amazed at the impression our students make when we take them to these locations. Total strangers would walk up to our chaperones and brag on our students being well dressed and well behaved.

All upper school office spaces will be used by our growing upper school administrative team. Please note that any parent or student interaction with the business office will be in Modular C. All those classrooms will be used for instruction.

You will be meeting several new teachers and staff who are very excited to be at Whitesburg Christian Academy. 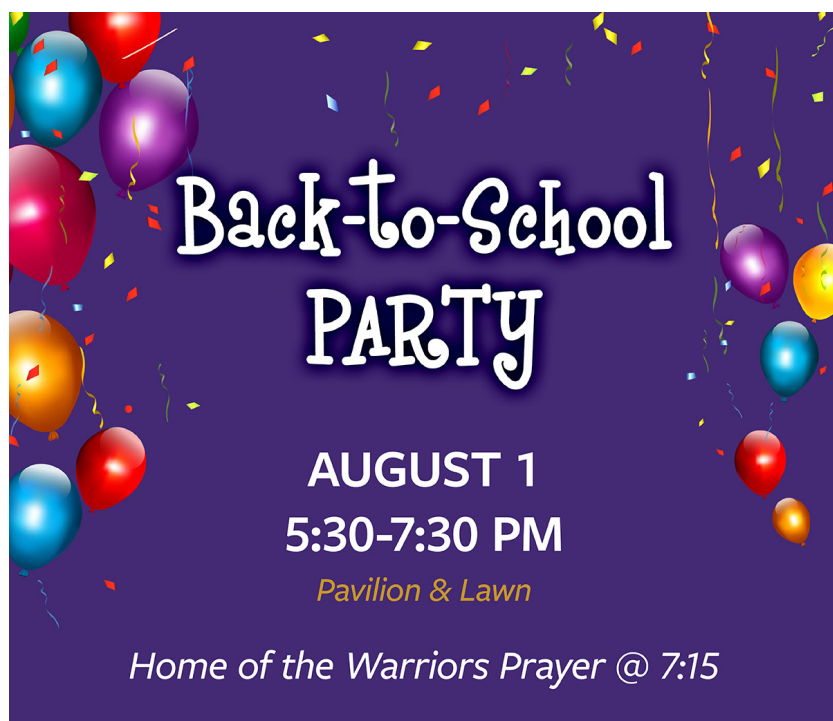

Lunch is **not** served on 1/2 days.

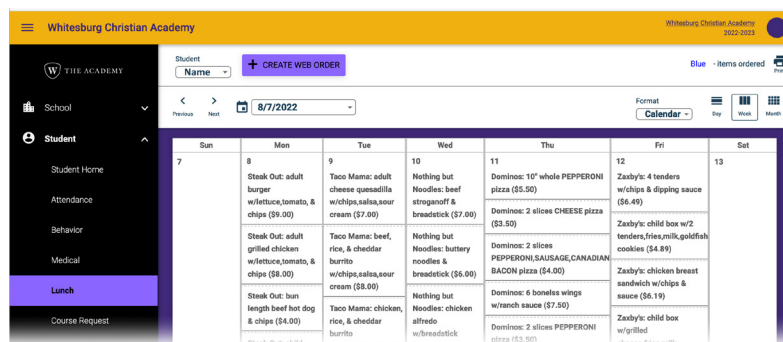

- Drop in. No registration required.
- There is **no after care** on 1/2 days.

## MORNING CARLINE/DROP OFF

- Drop off starts at 7:35 a.m.
- Please do not drop off students before staff members are present.
- Doors lock at 8:00 a.m. If you arrive late, please go to the front office for check in.
- All 3rd-6th graders who have a sibling in TK/K or Upper School can be dropped off in the Upper/TK/K carline area.
- Driving students with younger Grammar School siblings need to drive sibling through the morning carline.
- Please use the drop off areas ONLY! Students should not exit the car in any other place.
- **Upper School Late Start Wednesday** – when your club does not meet, **school will begin at 9:05 am**. Carline will be from 8:45–9:00 a.m.

## AFTERNOON CARLINE/DISMISSAL

- Please do NOT enter the carline until it is time for your student to be dismissed. If you are in the line prior to their dismissal, you will be asked to circle back around in order for the carline to keep moving. If you have children in different dismissal groups, enter the carline time of your oldest child (with the exception of TK/K) or circle back around for an additional pick up time.
- 1st-6th grade parents should park at the ROC until their dismissal time. This helps us keep traffic off Whitesburg Drive. Please see this map for details.
- **Grammar School students not picked up by 3:30 p.m. will go to after care.**
- **Upper School students must be pickup up by 3:40 p.m.**

## TIPS

- Always have your carline tag visible during pick up!
- Encourage your students to be ready to exit the car when you pull to into the carline area.
- Be patient. The carline always gets faster after the first two weeks!

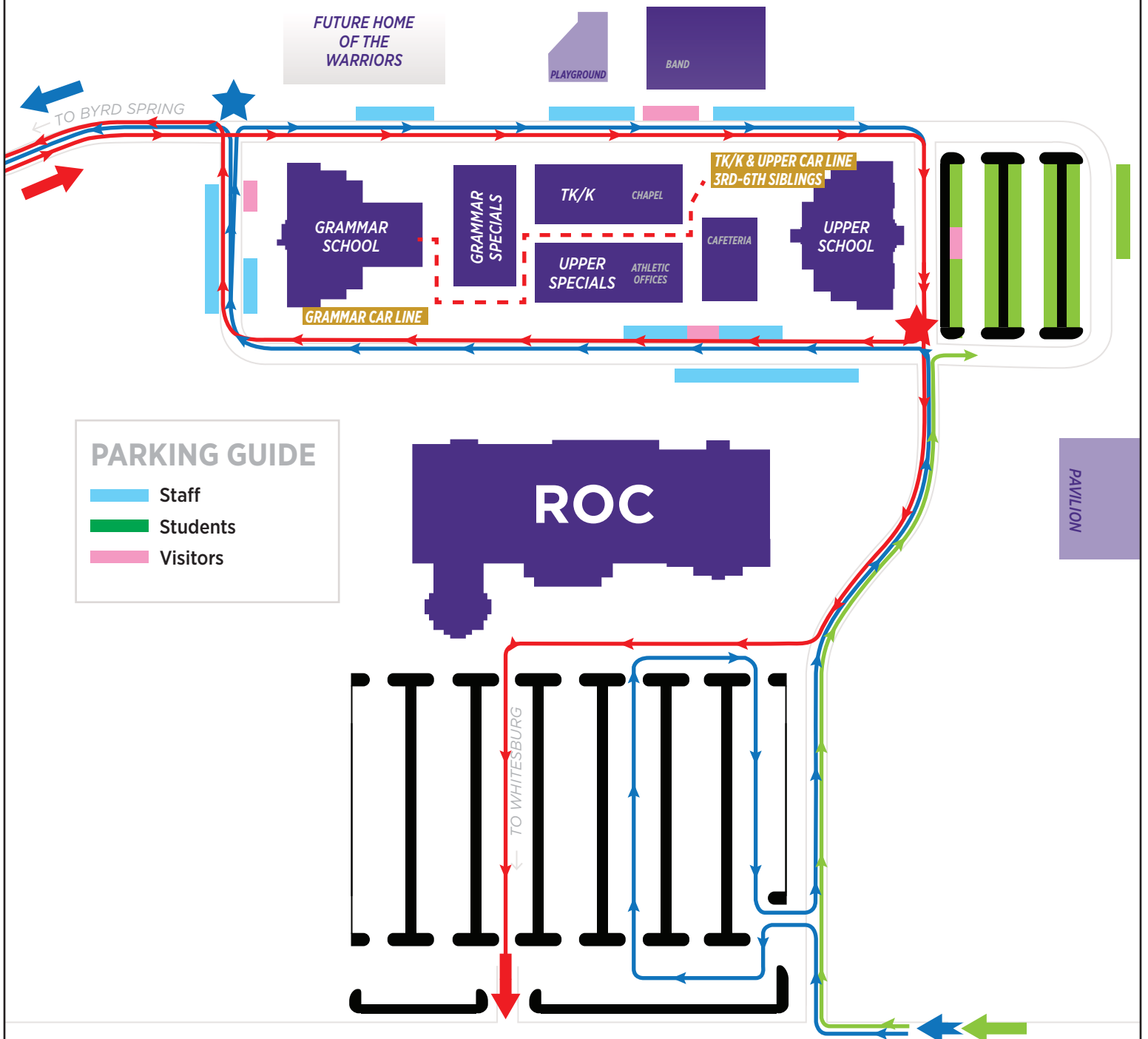

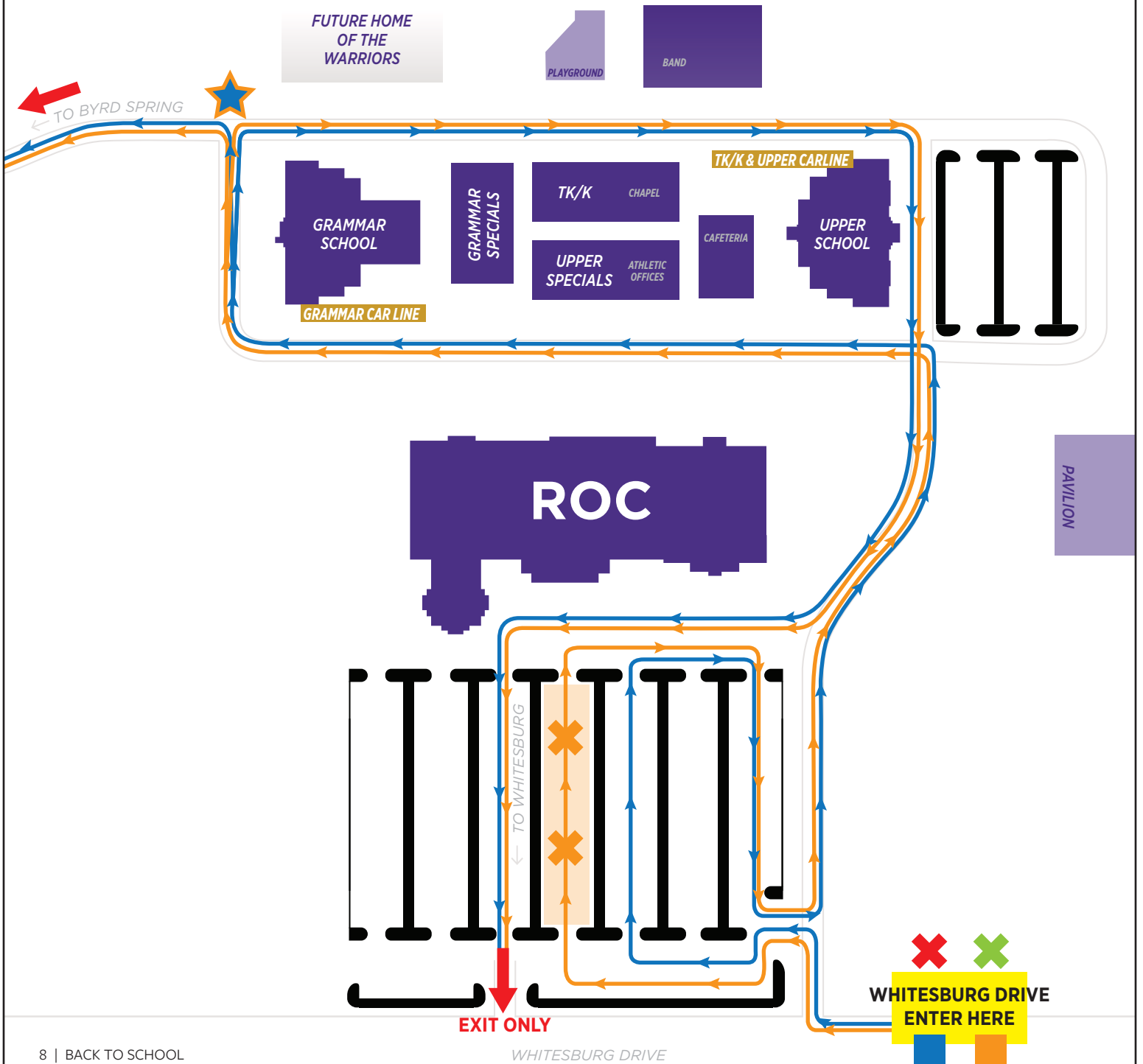

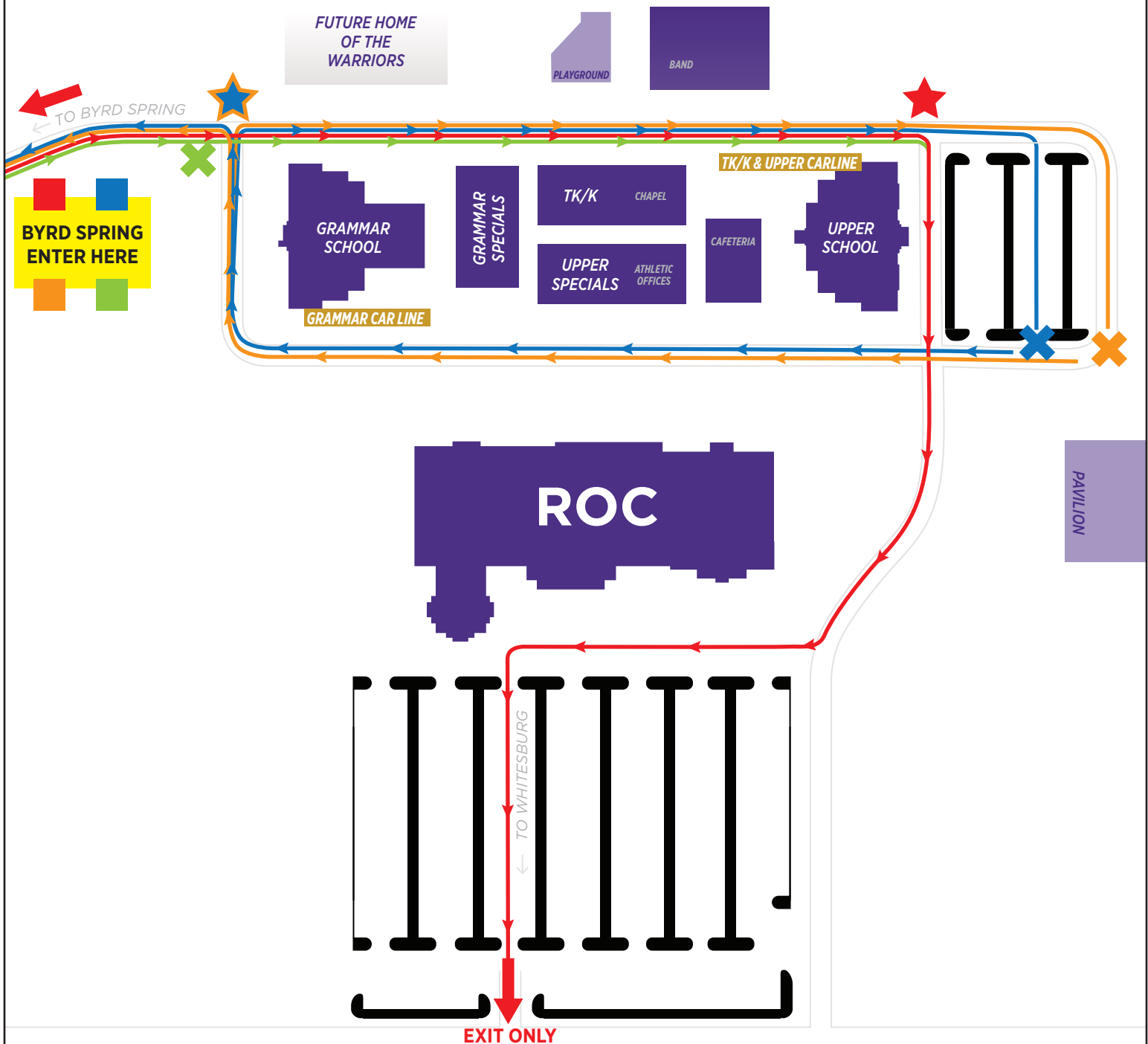

## LATE START WEDNESDAY

### ***Late Start to Get Ahead***

We are happy to continue Late Start Wednesdays for the Upper School this year. By starting later, it will actually help our teachers and students get ahead in many ways.

The purpose of late start Wednesday is to allow time for student clubs to meet and for teachers to collaborate at the department level and grade level. Student Clubs provide your students with important opportunities to demonstrate leadership, connect with their peers and faculty, and explore interests. With families' schedules being busy after school, we needed to find time during the school day to provide these opportunities. Teacher collaboration will greatly enhance the quality of instruction that your child will receive. Late Start Wednesday also provides an excellent time slot to schedule appointments for your child!

***What is Late Start Wednesday?*** On Wednesdays, school will start at 9:05 a.m. for Upper School.

***When is Upper School carline on Wednesday?*** Upper School carline will be from 8:45 – 9:00 a.m. on Wednesdays.

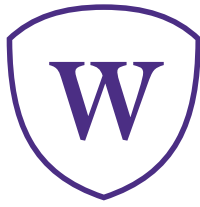
***What grades will be doing late start Wednesdays?*** Late Start Wednesdays are for grades 7-12 only.

***What time will school dismiss on Wednesdays?*** School will dismiss at the normal time, 3:30 p.m.

***What if I'm unable to bring my child to school at 9:00 on Wednesdays?*** We encourage families to carpool to accommodate the late start time on Wednesday. Please do not bring your child to school at 8:00 unless they are attending a club. Make sure they know where their club is meeting when you drop them off. We do not have supervision for them until carline begins at 8:45. **We will not have Study Hall this year.**

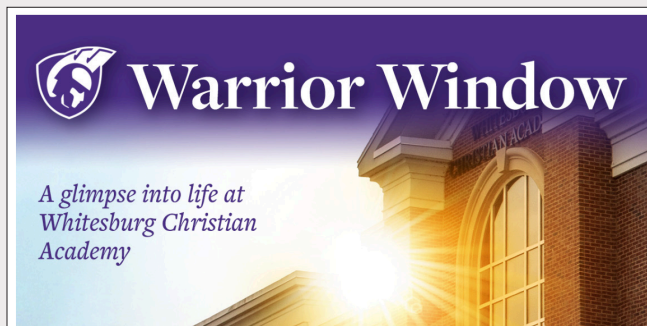
