

## IMPORTANT KINDERGARTEN IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION

The State of Florida requires by law that every Kindergarten student, new or returning, submit new medical forms (School Entry Health Exam and Certification of Immunization, signed by a licensed Florida physician. The original form must be submitted before the first day of school. Carrollton must comply with this law. Certain requirements begin in the Kindergarten year. Specifically, we will be checking your daughter's report for the following:

- **Diphtheria-Tetanus-Pertussis Series**
- **Haemophilus influenzae type b (Hib)-\*\*this is for pre-school in addition to the rest on this list\*\***
- **Hepatitis B**
- **Measles-Mumps-Rubella (MMR)**
- **Polio Series**
- **Varicella**

We ask that you check with your daughter's pediatrician to ensure her immunizations are current and obtain a new form showing compliance. If your daughter cannot receive a needed immunization, your physician can complete part B of the DH 680 form allowing for a temporary exemption that must include an expiration date. You may then submit this temporary exemption form to the admission office so that your daughter may comply with the start of school. Once the immunization is administered later, you will be required to submit an updated form to the office.

These reports, Form DH 680 Certificate of Immunization and DH 3040 School Entry Health Exam, must be received in the Admissions office prior to June 9, 2023
