

*APPLE BLOSSOM AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM  
SUMMER CAMP  
BEHAVIOR RULES*

The following are not permitted in the After School Program or Summer Camp:

Teasing, taunting or verbal harassment of other children.

Hitting, kicking, biting or any physical abuse towards a teacher or another child.

Any behavior where a child could harm himself/herself.

Running away or hiding from staff members.

Destroying or attempting to destroy the property of another child, a staff member or the school.

Any behavior that would force a teacher to use physical restraint.

Any behavior that would seriously disrupt the organization or sense of order of the program.

Any behavior intended to break down the system of mutual respect.

Not listening to a teacher or refusing to follow a teacher's instructions.

If a child breaks any of these rules, the parents will be informed.

Any child who continuously breaks these rules may be put on a "behavior contract."

The purpose of the contract is to help the child to understand what is expected of him/her and what steps will be taken if the behavior continues.

We believe this understanding will help your child to be responsible for his/her behavior and actions.

If serious violations of the rules continue, the following consequences may occur:

First violation - A verbal warning will be given.

Second violation - A verbal or written warning and a two-day or longer suspension will be given.

Third violation - Dismissal from the program.

Parents will be advised of their child's behavior on a regular basis.
