**RESOLUTION #21-22-05  
CONTINUING BOARD OF TRUSTEES AUTHORITY TO HOLD VIRTUAL  
MEETINGS PURSUANT TO AB361**

***October 14, 2021***

**WHEREAS**, on March 4, 2020, Governor Gavin Newsom declared a statewide emergency arising from the coronavirus (COVID-19); and

**WHEREAS**, on March 17, 2020, Governor Newsom issued Executive Order N-29-20 suspending certain provisions of the Brown Act pertaining to teleconferenced meetings; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 11, 2021, Governor Newsom issued Executive Order N-08-21 which indicated that Executive Order N-29-20's authorization for holding virtual meetings would expire on September 30, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 16, 2021, Governor Newsom signed AB 361 (Rivas) as urgency legislation effective immediately, which provides that legislative bodies may continue to meet remotely during a declared State of Emergency subject to certain conditions; and

**WHEREAS**, AB 361 amends the Brown Act (Government Code section 54953) to add the following provision:

(e)(1) A local agency may use teleconferencing without complying with the requirements of paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) if the legislative body complies with the requirements of paragraph (2) of this subdivision in any of the following circumstances:

(B) The legislative body holds a meeting during a proclaimed state of emergency for the purpose of determining, by majority vote, whether as a result of the emergency, meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees.; and

**WHEREAS**, AB 361 amends the Brown Act (Government Code section 54953) to add the following provision:

***Vision Statement:***

*Building tomorrow's leaders today.*

***Mission Statement:***

*Prepare all students to be responsible, resilient, resourceful, and productive world citizens in a changing and diverse society.*

**RESOLUTION #21-22-05**

(3) If a state of emergency remains active, or state or local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing, in order to continue to teleconference without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b), the legislative body shall, not later than 30 days after teleconferencing for the first time pursuant to subparagraph (A), (B), or (C) of paragraph (1), and every 30 days thereafter, make the following findings by majority vote:

(A) The legislative body has reconsidered the circumstances of the state of emergency.

(B) Any of the following circumstances exist:

(i) The state of emergency continues to directly impact the ability of the members to meet safely in person.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Trustees of Westminster School District finds that the Governor’s March 4, 2020 declaration of a state of emergency due to the COVID-19 pandemic remains active.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Board of Trustees of Westminster School District finds that due to the state of emergency meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees and/or the state of emergency continues to directly impact the ability of the members to meet safely in person due to the prevalence of the Delta variant, the indoor setting of meeting facilities, the potential presence of unvaccinated individuals attending meetings, the potential for noncompliance with mask wearing requirements, and desire to protect the health of immuno-compromised trustee(s), staff and the public and therefore, the Board of Trustees of the Westminster School District wish to meet utilizing the provisions of AB 361.;

Public Comments

Ms. Claudia Steinmetz said with the new director of nutrition services in place she hoped to see fresh, nutrition-rich, and healthy lunches for all students. She asked the Board to not go against CDPH guidelines regarding masks.

Ms. Dana Bailey Culver asked that staff and educators be proven vaccinated before returning to school.

Mr. Adam Kent – Mr. Kent’s comment was cut short due to it being a sales pitch.

Ms. Blanca Driskill said she is in favor of masking requirements, socially distancing and requiring staff to be vaccinated and tested weekly. She said the District should have a plan in place for the Dual Language Immersion as the Virtual Academy does not support the program. Ms. Driskill said data should continue to be available on the WSD Covid Dashboard.

Dr. Kelly Phan is in favor of requiring staff to have proof of vaccinations and mask requirements. She also said the District should have a DLI plan so kids don’t miss out on academic curriculum.

Lauren Hernandez asked the Board to add “Mask Choice” to a board agenda. Ms. Hernandez is not in favor of masks, quarantines, and asymptomatic testing.

Mr. Duane and Mrs. Danielle Osterlind are in favor of mask mandates, outdoor teaching in safe, shaded spaces whenever possible. They said we must prioritize the mental health of our families. They asked the Board to be mindful of how we send messages to students saying positive wordsmithing is essential to foster joyful

October 14, 2021

Under current consortium budget agreements, any unfunded cost of non-public school/agency placement is a cost to the general fund of the resident district. It is recommended that the following NPSA/NPA contract/addendum be approved and that the West Orange County Consortium for Special Education be authorized to receive invoices and process payments.

Services required are determined by the student's Individualized Education Program (IEP).

**WHEREAS**, in November of 1979, the California electorate did adopt Proposition 4, commonly called the Gann Amendment, which added Article XIII-B to the California Constitution; and,

**WHEREAS**, the provisions of that Article establish maximum appropriation limitations, commonly called “Gann Limits,” for public agencies, including school districts; and,

**WHEREAS**, the District must establish a revised Gann limit for the 2020-21 fiscal year and a projected Gann Limit for the 2021-22 fiscal year in accordance with the provisions of Article XIII-B and applicable statutory law;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Trustees of the Westminster School district hereby resolves and declares as follows:

The calculations and documentation of the Gann limits for 2020-21 is at \$62,865,712.27 and for 2021-22 at \$63,722,792.59, are made in accord with applicable constitutional and statutory law;

The appropriations in the Budget for the 2020-21 and 2021-22 fiscal years do not exceed the limitations imposed by Proposition 4;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the documentation used in determining the appropriations limit, shall be available to the public at the Westminster School District office at 14121 Cedarwood Avenue, Westminster, CA 92683.

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**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

California Education Code Section 60119 specifies that the governing boards of school districts are required to hold annual public hearings on the sufficiency of textbooks and adopt a resolution that all students have sufficient textbooks and instructional materials in each subject area consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the State Board.

Each spring, pupil projections are analyzed to monitor student enrollment for the following school year. Textbooks and instructional materials are ordered with a 10% margin to ensure sufficient texts are available for students each fall.

Middle school students check-out textbooks in each subject, which are kept at home. A classroom set of textbooks, in each subject area, is also available to students during class. This system provides students the access to instructional materials at school and at home.

**CURRENT CONSIDERATIONS:**

Educational Code Section 60119 requires governing boards to hold an open hearing and invite public testimony prior to adoption of a resolution assuring that students have or will have sufficient textbooks and instructional materials.

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**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

Each year school districts and county offices of education must ensure that they have fully complied with the requirements of California Education Code Section 60119. The governing boards of school districts are required to hold annual public hearings on the sufficiency of textbooks and adopt a resolution that all students have sufficient textbooks and instructional materials that are aligned to the content standards adopted pursuant to Section 60605 in each subject area.

Each spring, pupil projections are analyzed to monitor student enrollment for the following school year. Textbooks and instructional materials are ordered with a 10% margin to ensure sufficient texts are available for students each fall.

Middle school students check-out textbooks in each subject, which are kept at home. A classroom set of textbooks, in each subject area, is also available to students during class. This system provides students the access to instructional materials at school and at home.

**CURRENT CONSIDERATIONS:**

Under current law, Educational Code Section 60119 requires governing boards to hold an open hearing and invite public testimony prior to adoption of a resolution assuring that students have or will have sufficient textbooks and instructional materials within the first eight weeks of school.
