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

Did You Know?

All Sun Prairie East High School, Sun Prairie West High School, and Prairie Phoenix Academy classrooms are now equipped with Stop the Bleed kits. The District has had Stop the Bleed (STB) kits and trained staff in our schools since 2017. After the first active threat drill last year, SP West student Aliza Kruger spearheaded a project to get an STB kit in every high school classroom and to get training and education about Stop the Bleed out to students. **She applied for and received \$9,000 in grants from the Sun Prairie Education Foundation and By Youth For Youth.**

Students assembled STB kits, and one will hang by the door in every high school classroom. All students had the opportunity to watch a video about what to do if someone has severe bleeding and then got a chance to practice hands-on during lunches. Thank you to Aliza Kruger, Chad Whalley, Elizabeth Feisthommel, Dr. Lohmeier from UW Health, Deputy Longley, and Sun Prairie EMS/Fire/Police for supporting this important student safety initiative.

There is a clear and positive correlation between student learning and consistent, prompt attendance in class. Much of what is presented in courses is sequential. 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

Did You Know?

Our District is committed to disrupting inequities that contribute to the school-to-prison pipeline for our students, and we are committed to social-emotional wellness for all students. It is our belief that **engaging in system-wide learning and implementation around Restorative Practices, Restorative Circles, Restorative Justice, and alternatives to discipline will lead to more equitable outcomes for our Black and Brown students.** Restorative Practices empower students to work together to engage in processes that restore harm when a previously established connection between two or more individuals has been broken. Students and staff work together to find solutions before resorting to severe disciplinary actions.

Implementing and engaging in Restorative Practices within our system represents a culture shift that will take time. A multi-year system-wide implementation plan is necessary to achieve lasting, desired outcomes. Our three middle schools began using Restorative Practices last year, while our three high schools began implementation this year along with C. H. Bird, Meadow View, and Westside elementary schools. 

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


Did You Know?

Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID) is a college- and career-readiness system that was adopted by the Sun Prairie Area School District in 2011. The program includes the AVID Elective course for identified students in grades 7–12 and AVID Schoolwide, which ensures all students in grades 6–12 have access to key strategies to become college, career, and community ready.

The AVID Elective, which currently serves over 600 students, is designed to support students in the academic middle and/or students who are part of a racial, cultural, or economic group historically underrepresented in colleges and universities. Students in the AVID Elective engage in **activities centered around exploring college and career opportunities**, such as visiting college campuses and welcoming business and community leaders into the classroom. **Since the inception of the program, 100% of our AVID Elective graduates have been accepted to a two-year or four-year college or university and have collectively earned millions of dollars in scholarship money.**





Did You Know?

The Sun Prairie Area School District and our design partners achieved 2022 Climate Champion status for West High School for the use of geothermal heat pumps, LED lighting, heat recovery units, a 285 kW PV solar array, and control strategies, including occupancy sensors to help reduce energy consumption.

The school was designed to use about half as much energy as a comparable school. Additionally, as of spring 2023, the solar array has already produced over 385 MWh of electricity, the equivalent of over 50 typical homes' electricity use for a full year, and we have seen days where the meter associated with the solar array has "spun backward," selling energy back to Sun Prairie Utilities.

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

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






Did You Know?
