

Campbell County Preschool Program Information

Enrollment	<p>PRESCHOOL SCREENING INFORMATION</p> <p>All students must be screened prior to preschool enrollment to ensure he or she meets the district's current qualification criteria for preschool enrollment. A link to the preschool screening form can be found on the district website under the Special Education/Preschool Department.</p> <p>YOUR CHILD MAY QUALIFY IF:</p> <p>The child is a Campbell County Schools resident AND</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Is 3 or 4 years old and displays delays in speech and/or challenges in attaining developmental skills that are needed to be successful in school. Required ages are as of August 1 of the current school year. ● Is 4 years old by August 1 of the current school year and the family qualifies financially. The Household Income Form and other preschool forms are posted under documents on the department webpage. You may submit this form to your school. <p>Children who are 4 years old by August 1 of the current school year but do not meet the eligibility requirements of either delays or finances may attend as a "Universal 4" at no cost if there is space available.</p> <p>For additional questions, please call 859-635-2173 and ask for preschool screening information or your districted school for more information.</p>
Days and Times	<p>Monday - Thursday</p> <p>8:30-11:30 AM OR 12:20-3:20 PM (TIMES ARE APPROXIMATE)</p>
Transportation	<p>AM/PM – Home to School and School to Home</p> <p>AM/PM assignment is based on transportation boundaries and is not related to IEP or car rider status. Questions about boundaries should be directed to the transportation department at 859-635-2161.</p>
Curriculum	<p>Research Based Curriculum and High Scope—Learning through experiences Home Visits – twice per year, usually on a Friday (may be virtual)</p>
Classroom Visit	<p>Parents are encouraged to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Contact your school for procedures for class visits. ● Arrange a visit with the classroom teacher. ● Make a visit with your child to your preschool classroom.
Students Attending a Private School	<p>Preschool students who are placed in a private/home school do not qualify for service plans. If a student meets eligibility criteria for speech services, that student must be enrolled in the public school by his or her parent in order to receive services under an IEP. Services shall be offered within the school day for 30 minutes per week.</p>
