## **Kindergarten and First Grade**

- Please fill out forms available on Final Forms pertaining to the use and care of your student's chromebook.
- Insurance information is available via Final Forms. Insurance is \$25 for the entire year and will cover the cost to repair any accidental damage. Please make checks payable to Louisville City Schools or purchase it through your PaySchools account.

## **Grade 2, Grade 3, Grade 4 and Grade 5**

- Student chromebooks will be sent home each night.
- Each student will also have a case for his/her chromebook.
- Student's are expected to charge his/her chromebook each night.
- Please fill out forms available on Final Forms pertaining to the use and care of your student's chromebook.
- Insurance information is available via Final Forms. Insurance is \$25 for the entire year and will cover the cost to repair any accidental damage. Please make checks payable to Louisville City Schools or purchase it through your PaySchools account..
