We are excited to announce that we are switching from iPass to Powerschool. PowerSchool is familiar to many families already, and we are happy to report it is very user friendly! All returning families will receive an email from PowerSchool with a unique link to create an account, verify information, upload documents such as a current physical, and to sign off on yearly items. We ask that you please complete this information within a few days of receiving the email to assist us in our conversion to PowerSchool. Please note - grade 9 families and transfer families should already have completed this process.
