- Through short stories, personal narratives and novel snippets, students will begin to engage with text on a deeper level through personal connections and relatable conversations.

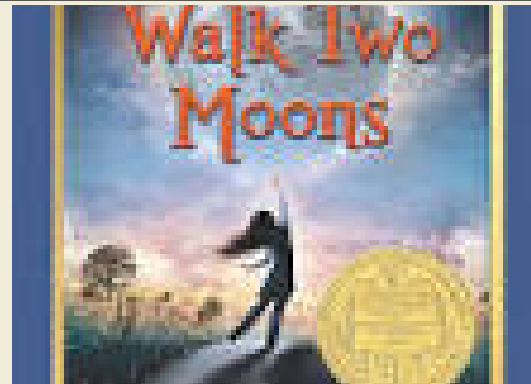
Students will engage with narrative stories, build rich vocabularies as they began to research independently and process through synthesizing information.



- Through a deep analysis of memoirs, film and biographies, students will connect with the author's purpose and need to tell their story.

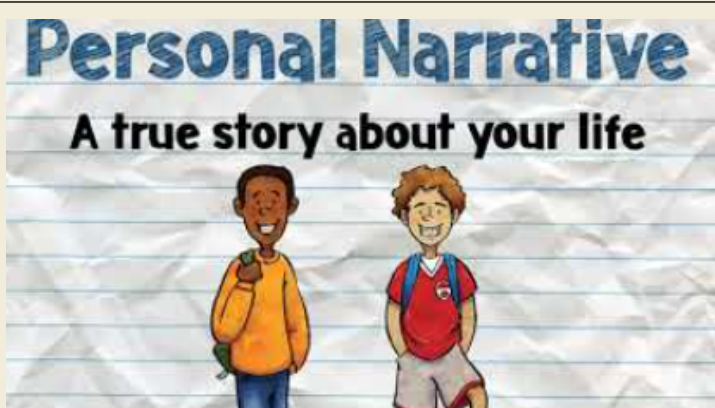


- Through different forms of informational text, students are able to research and build knowledge through technology and collaboration.

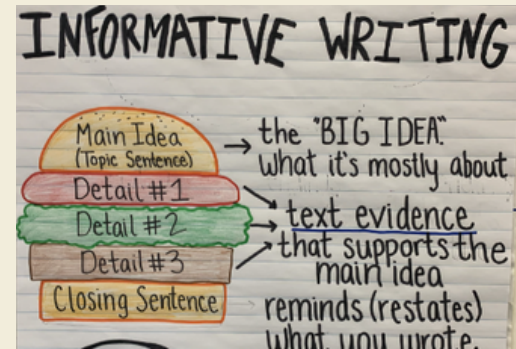


- Through different genres, students will connect all their learning by applying their learning to a novel.
