



# Senior Picture Day

## What to Expect

### Before Picture Day

- Seniors and parents are responsible for booking their senior's session online and paying the session fees before the scheduled event at the school
- Our studio team brings the following scenes:
  - Yearbook Formal
  - Cap & Gown
  - Timeless
  - Exposure

**Note:** Seniors must **book their sessions online at [cady.com/seniorpics](https://cady.com/seniorpics)** prior to the scheduled picture day. They will receive emails from CADY to prepare and remind them about their upcoming session at the school.

### During Picture Day

- **120 minutes before start time (Senior Roadshow):** CADY team will arrive to set-up for the event
- Seniors will arrive at the set-up location for their scheduled session time, check in, and are then photographed at their selected scenes
- After the session is completed, the senior will check out at the front table. We explain the proof viewing process and each senior is given a sheet explaining what to expect next

**Note:** Seniors are welcome to bring multiple outfits, props, and anything that helps showcase their personality, if in accordance with school policy—encourage them to visit our [session prep page](#). Seniors should arrive photo ready (hair & makeup done) but are welcome to change outfits between scenes, provided the school has accessible bathrooms or locker rooms.

### After Picture Day

- **21 days after:** CADY will email and text seniors and parents when proofs are available to view in their online account
- Proofs will also be delivered to their home in a viewing portfolio or proof mailer. They will have 60 days from the date of their session to purchase or return their portfolio, or else they will be charged the full price of the portfolio. This shipment also contains a brochure with available packages, add-ons, wall art, and retouching options that can be ordered online

**Note:** Seniors and parents will order online at [cady.com/seniorpics](https://cady.com/seniorpics) and orders will be shipped to their home, not to the school.
