1. Hair:





a. Females: OK

- i. Cannot be more than 4 inches in bulk
 - ii. Hair extensions must be the same color as your natural hair.
 - iii. Ponytails cannot pass below a line drawn from the bottom of the armpits
 - iv. Hair buns cannot extend more than 4 inches from the scalp
 - v. Hair cannot be shaved on the sides
 - vi. Must all be the same natural color (no crayon reds, yellows, greens, blues, pinks, etc.)

Not OK:







b. Males: OK

- Ividies. Or
 - i. Bangs cannot extend passed the eyebrowsii. No dreads, twists, cornrows, locs, extensions, designs
 - iii. Hair must be smooth on the top (no ruffles or twists)
 - iv. Cannot be more than 2.5" of bulk
 - v. Cannot touch the ears
 - vi. Must be tapered towards the scalp (no mushroom tops)
 - vii. "high and tights" or shaved heads are OK
 - viii. No hair color for males



2. Fingernails: Not OK:

- a. Females
 - i. Cannot be longer than a quarter of an inch (1/4")
 - ii. No bright colors (reds, yellows, greens, blues, pinks, etc.)
 - iii. No designs, no sparkles, no jewels
 - iv. All nails must be identical/match
- b. Males
 - i. Must be clean
 - ii. Polish is not authorized

3. Jewelry

- a. All cadets:
 - i. One bracelet is OK, but it must be gold or silver
 - ii. Necklaces are OK, but must be hidden (tucked into shirt)
 - iii. Rings are OK, but only 3 are allowed
- b. Piercings:
 - i. No facial piercings (nose rings, eyebrow rings, lip rings, cheek studs, etc.)
 - ii. Only 1 set of earrings in the lowest hole pierced
 - 1. Can only be 4mm in size, round or square studs
 - iii. MALES: No piercings of any kind
