Service Animal/Emotional Support Animal Consent to Share Residence Form

When a student with a disability has an accommodation for a Service or Emotional Support Animal in Campus Housing, the College must inform roommates/suitemates that an animal will be living in the residence. **All** roommates or suitemates of the owner must sign this agreement acknowledging that the animal will be in residence with them **prior** to the arrival of the animal on campus property. In the event, that one or more roommates/suitemates does not approve, the Office of Student Housing will make necessary room changes, if feasible. Students may contact Missy Kelsay, Disability Coordinator if they have a health or safety related concern about the exposure to a specific animal. The College will reasonably accommodate individuals with medical conditions that require accommodations when living in proximity to Service Animals or Emotional Support Animals.
