Additional funding to the Douglas County School District via potential future Mill Levy Overrides and Bond initiatives benefit our town in many ways. For example:

- Provide more competitive pay for teachers and staff, so that Castle Rock keeps its highquality educators here in our community.
- Increase and maintain school security support such as School Resource Officers, and implement school safety and security upgrades.
- Provide additional Career and Technical Education opportunities for students.
- Keep Castle Rock school buildings safe and adequate for students and staff, and increase capacity to reduce overcrowding.

**Additional Bond funding would** enable DCSD to build a new elementary school in the Crystal Valley neighborhood and an expansion at Mesa Middle School.





### Douglas County School District Funding Needs in Castle Rock


When Home Values Go Up Does School Funding Automatically Increase?

 An increase in local funding due to economic growth and rising property taxes does NOT provide our schools with more money, it just means the state contributes less.

### **Mill Levy Overrides (MLO)**

Each school district can request additional local funding through a local Mill Levy Override (MLO). This funding is generally used for operations, including salaries, staffing, and student programming. A potential 2023 MLO for the Douglas County School District would provide teachers and staff in every Castle Rock public school (neighborhood and charter) with more competitive pay and would provide more security (including School Resource Officers) in Castle Rock schools.

Because other school districts in the Denver Metro area have continuously passed voter-approved local measures to increase their funding, our school district now receives \$2,000 less per student than Cherry Creek School District and Littleton Public Schools (equivalent to a gap of \$130 million per year).



\*MLO per student is total MLO divided by funded pupil count; Average teacher salaries are from CDE data for the 2021-2022 school year.

Per Colorado Department of Education, Douglas County School District's General Administration Spending Per Student is \$63 vs. \$149 in Littleton Public Schools and \$189 in Denver Public Schools.

#### **Bonds**

Local voter-approved general obligation bonds are used by school districts for capital needs such as constructing new school buildings or additions to existing school buildings, facility repairs and upgrades, security upgrades, classroom equipment, buses, and technology.
