Immunization Requirements for Students Entering 7th Grade

The Ohio Department of Health requires all students to receive the following immunizations prior to entering 7th grade:

- <u>One (1) dose of Meningococcal [MCV4] vaccine</u> (A second dose of meningococcal vaccine will be required prior to entry into the 12th grade)
- One (1) dose of Tdap [tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis] vaccine

Your 7th grade student will need to show proof of having received the Meningococcal [MCV4] vaccine and the Tdap booster before they can return to school for the 2023-2024 school year. Section 3313.671 of the Ohio Revised Code states that students who do not provide documentation of these immunizations will be excluded from school on the 15th day after school entrance, until proof is provided.

In Strongsville City Schools, students who do not have documentation on file will be excluded from school beginning September 25, 2023 (Exemptions are provided for under law. Call if you would like more information)

Please contact your health care provider or the County Board of Health at 216-201-2041 to schedule an appointment if your student has not yet received these immunizations.
