April 20, 2023

1. Reviewed minutes from the March 16, 2023, meeting, which were approved.
2. Due to interest from the Knowlton community, it has been decided that we will have two full-day Kindergarten classes and one half-day class for the year 2023-24. One upper grade class will move to a portable to make room for the extra Kindergarten class.
3. The TSSP (Teacher Student Success Plan) for 2023-24 budget was reviewed and approved. All Community Council members who were present signed the plan.
4. Building improvements to our school are underway. The new sound system in the gym has been installed and is working great. New carpet for the building will be installed during the summer. We are also looking at improvements in the library area including filling in the kiva with cement and closing it off to create a new workspace or classroom.
5. There will be openings on the Community Council board for the upcoming school year 2023-24. Hailey Kunz, Eryn Parr, and Stacey Anderson will remain on the council. Everyone else has served for at least two years and will be replaced. The openings will be announced this spring to get the word out and spread interest. It will also be announced at Back to School Night in the fall and applications will be made available. There will be a 10-day window following BTSN to accept and review applications. New members will be introduced at the September meeting.
6. Possible new designs to update our Knowlton Colts logo were shared by Jeri. It will be on the marquee outside in front of the school as well as on the Knowlton letterhead and in other places. The proposed designs were passed around and input was given.
7. Other: It was brought up that during the upcoming Mileage Club week, students will only be allowed to run at lunchtime when PTO members can be out to supervise and give punches on their cards. Teachers are not allowed to take their classes out on their own time to run. Also, it was noted that the busing situation seems to be getting better and is not consistently late in the afternoons as it has been in past months.
8. Jeri thanked everyone for their service on the Community Council this past year and the meeting was adjourned.
