

ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY

Students who are involved in extracurricular activities must adhere to the following academic eligibility standards:

Students must be making progress toward graduation to maintain their eligibility.

A student falling into category 3 will be placed on probation. During the probation period, the student must be passing all current course work to remain eligible for extra curricular activities. If the student is failing any course, he/she would lose eligibility immediately until enough course work is completed to move back into category 1 or 2. Probation will not be carried into the next school year. Students on probation must earn enough credits during the current school year or over the summer to move back into category 1 or 2.

A review board consisting of an Assistant Principal, a Counselor, a Teacher, and the Activities Director, who will act as chairman, will be set up to deal with any student who wishes to appeal the above ruling. The appeal shall be made in writing and shall be submitted to the Principal.

*Category 2 represents a minimum standard. Eligibility would be lost if a student in category 2 fails another class during his/her high school career.

The Academic Eligibility policy applies to all extra curricular activities (athletic, fine arts and clubs).
