1) Call to Order

Chairman Joey Shive called the meeting to order. Donnie Perry led the invocation.

3) Superintendent Report

Superintendent Josh Hurt

- Welcome to Mr. Joseph Eaton, his first official meeting as principal of Metcalfe County High School.
- The roof on the high school is making progress. Crews are working on downspouts and gutters, etc. Expect it to be wrapped up before school starts. We are working on getting updated drone pics.
- Soil testing is taking place for new buildings and grounds projects. We are waiting on some drawings for the athletic complex ahead of starting the bid process.
- Elementary and middle school staffing for the new school year is good. Cafeteria and bus garage staffing is good. High school is close with just a few staffing positions to fill. Statewide staff turnover is approx. 21%. In Metcalfe that number is 7%. We are very pleased with the direction we are heading.
- ServPro came in to clean up some damage from recent storms. Everything is all good now.
- We are working on wrapping up the year financially and feel good about where we are.
 Our folks have a good balance on spending versus student need.
- 5D is a request from the Council for Better Education for \$1,200 to help protect public schools from losing taxpayer dollars to fund charter schools. The council is asking all 171 Kentucky public school districts to donate.
- 5E is asking for an assistant dance coach at the high school. Interest in the renewed program has been exceptional. So much so that more help is needed. If approved, the middle school dance coach position will now become the high school assistant dance coach position.

- 5F has to do with former MCHS principal Clint Graham, who is now working for the Kentucky Department of Education. This agenda item will allow us to pay his salary, and we will get 100% reimbursed from KDE. Reimbursement will be quarterly.
- 5G is for an emergency certification for a math teacher at the high school. The teacher is qualified for grades 5-9. If approved, the teacher will be allowed to teach at the high school while getting certified in upper-level math.

Robin McMurtrey: GRREC may be able to assist financially in the math certification.
