Scoops 7:30-8:15 am programs all student enter main building doors sign in to attend special activities each day. Before going to class students will collect breakfast from cafeteria.

Coming to School

ALL ADULTS ON CAMPUS BETWEEN 8am and 3:30 pm **MUST CHECK IN WITH THE OFFICE VIA Main Entrance** AND HAVE A BADGE PARENTS MAYNOT enter via any other building doors. Please let your child come to class independently



Arrival 8:15-8:30

- Bus
- Park and walk

Tardy after 8:30

If after 8:30 am guardian(s) must sign student in at office before student walks to class from main lobby.

Bus Riders

- A staff member will be there to greet you as you get off the bus PK-K students either a Pk/K staff member will be there to escort group to class
- 1-6th grade students will grab breakfast in cafeteria and head to correct playground or late arrivals go to class

Walkers

- Cross at designated crosswalk areas.
- Stay with adult or older sibling.
- Wait for crossing guards signals.
- 1-6th Go to cafeteria to grab breakfast head to correct playground or late arrivals go to class
- If after 8:30 am parent(s) must sign student in at office before student walks to class from main lobby.

Drop Off Line



Parents please remain in your vehicle
- PK-K drop off near ECE doors via front parking lot. Primary teachers will explain breakfast and procedures after drop off.

AM Drop Off Line



- 1-6th drop off either in lane near Loma

 Del Escolar or font of building

 Students can use Lobby deers or walk
 - -Students can use Lobby doors or walk to breakfast near primary playground

Please Drive Slowly



Two Lanes

 Our parking lot is two lanes. The inside lane is for cars that are driving through to parking spaces or exiting the drop off lane.

The outside lane (closest to the curb) is the car drop off lane.
 Please do not drive in the inside lane and cut into the drop off line.

 You need to wait your turn in the line and may pull out into the other lane when your student has been safely dropped off. PLEASE CONTINUE TO KEEP THE LINE MOVING

Seat Belts


- If your child needs help with his/her seatbelt the safest way to help is parking and walking your child to the building.

No Drop Off/Pick up Around Perimeter of the School.

 Students may not be dropped off/picked up at any other locations on or around Loma Del Escolar or Barranca Road.

Late Drop Off/Early Pick Up

- Students arriving after 8:30am must be checked in at window in the lobby
- Any doctor's notes, excuses, etc. can be turned at the window
- This is also the window that you will come to if you need to check your student out early from school or if you have a meeting
- Latest office will check out students on full days is 3:00 pm half days: 11:30 am




